Farmed, vinified & bottled by our family to yours. Our estate vineyard is 4.3 planted acres of Pinot Noir. Small, yes, but this allows our family to farm it exclusively- keeping diligent contact with every vine from bud break to harvest.

The 2021 vintage was our vineyard's fifth growing season, and just our second harvest off our vines. Now that the vines have started to mature, we are seeing an increase of yield, allowing us to create small, distinctive blends from each of our seven blocks (blocks are separated by soil, rootstock, clone and elevation) to showcase the site's personality. Our site is home to four distinctive soils (volcanic & siltstone) that we planted five different clones of Pinot Noir- each giving defining characteristics for flavor and structure.

The 2021 vintage was very unique in that it was the hottest growing season on record, with the epitome being a 'heat dome' weather system moving in at the end of June that reached 109F, 110F and 117F for three consecutive days. From there, the rest of the growing season kept a pace with 90- and 100-degree days causing surreal ripening that led to our earliest pick ever.

Our 2021 Pinot Noir Blend 2 is a four-barrel blend showcasing the bolder side of our vineyard. More black fruit driven & earthy, with heavier weight and more defined tannins.
