



We are thrilled to offer our farm as a premier location for you to capture your client's photos. Lavender Life Company & Farm is a secluded retreat, nestled just north of Green Lake and 20 minutes south of Grand Rapids, Michigan. With nearly 30 acres of lavender fields, palatial ponds, wildflower gardens, sprawling hayfields, and much more, the farm provides many venues allowing you to find a truly unique one-of-a-kind background for all your photography needs.

The farm is open to the public during photography sessions unless otherwise noted. There is a maximum of 5 photographers and their clients per hour. You are welcome to use all areas of the farm, however, we ask that you do not ask any of our guests to move to accommodate your photo shoot. With almost 30 acres there is room for everyone!

Rates are based on one photographic subject (one family, one senior, one couple, etc). Photographers wanting to host mini sessions will be charged the mini session fee.

PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES

- Please follow the photography parking signs. No vehicles will be allowed outside of the designated parking areas. Photographers and their clients will be asked to check in at the information/photo check in area upon arrival.
- We ask that photographers and their clients be respectful of the lavender/flowers by staying on the pathways and not crossing over flower beds. Picking flowers is forbidden. However, lavender bundles are available for purchase the day of your shoot.
- Props are allowed but must be preapproved 72 hours in advance (Pets are not allowed. Service animals only). All props brought onto the property must be removed immediately after your session. Outside food & drinks are not permitted.
- Lavender Life Company assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to any equipment or belongings.
- A Certificate of Insurance listing Lavender Life Company as an additional insured in the amount of \$100,000 is required within 72 hours of your assigned shoot.
- Proper attire is required during all photo shoots. We do not allow boudoir photography or risqué attire photography.
- A staff member will be on site to oversee all photography as well as answer any questions you may have during your shoot. If your shoot is scheduled during our Harvest Celebrations your guest will receive a complimentary ticket that can be used before or after their shoot to ensure they can experience the farm, shop in the barn, and enjoy treats from our bakery.
- Photographers can arrive one hour prior to their scheduled shoot to scout locations/set up.
- Clients should arrive dressed and ready for their shoot no more than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled start time.
- Photographers should meet their clients at the photography check-in area. A wardrobe changing area is not provided as space is limited.
- It is the responsibility of the photographer to share these guidelines with their clients.
- Please be mindful of your time spent on the farm – it is important to remain on schedule. If you are running behind additional time may be purchased the day of IF space is available. All photographers must return to the Photography Check In area upon completion of their scheduled shoot(s).
- Please note that the farm is also our home. It is a private drive and private property. We ask that you be respectful of our property and that you take great care of the grounds and the structures you will be using while on the farm. We ask that you do not trespass on our property during non-business hours.
- To reserve your photo session(s), please complete the attached Photography Request Form and return to info@Lavender-Life.com. **Full payment is required to reserve your date and is non-refundable. We will happily reschedule sessions for inclement weather.**
