



## **Student Entry Requirements VET Student Loans**

**Equal and Fair Treatment Policy and Procedure** 

As an approved VET Student Loan provider, Holmes Commercial Colleges (Melbourne) Ltd (herein referred as Melbourne School of Fashion) has fair and transparent procedures that Melbourne School of Fashion reasonably believes are based on merit for making decisions about the selection of students seeking to enrol in approved VSL courses; and the treatment of such students.

FashionMasters has a fair and transparent procedures, based on merit for making decisions about:

- a) the selection, from among Potential Students; and
- b) the treatment of Students.

Potential Students seeking to enrol in a VET unit of study or course with the Melbourne School of Fashion, regardless of their background, circumstances or eligibility for funding, will be assessed for entry to study through the same published entry requirements and through the same process.

The above paragraph does not prevent the Melbourne School of Fashion considering, in making decisions mentioned above, educational disadvantages that a particular Student or Potential Student has experienced or the fact that the student or Potential Student may be enrolled via a VET restricted access arrangement.

All students will be assessed for their academic suitability for the individual course they have applied for and Melbourne School of Fashion requires that all prospective students supply:

- a) Provide a copy of your Senior Secondary Certificate of Education (Year 12 certificate or VCAL) as awarded by an Australian State or Territory, or
- b) Provide a copy of a Certificate IV qualification or higher (providing that this qualification was delivered in English), or
- c) Complete the VSL approved LLN Robot Online Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) evaluation and attain a minimum score of exit level three across all categories. Melbourne School of Fashion will provide students with the results of their assessment in reading and numeracy as soon as practicable after the assessment. FashionMasters will make the results of the student's reading and numeracy assessment available to the Secretary, in the form, manner and by the time requested by the Secretary.

## **Selection and Admission procedure**

- 1. Students and persons seeking to enroll need to attending a Course information enrolment Session.

  Applicants should ensure they have any and all necessary documentation to support their application;
  - a) demonstrate that they meet the entry requirements for their chosen course;
  - b) if required to provide copies of previous qualifications, applicants must provide either original copies of transcripts from the originating institution, or should provide verified copies
- 2. Students seeking to enroll attend a face to face interview, and undertake a Pre-Training Review which includes Application, suitability and appropriateness assessment, Government Subsidy and VSL eligibility assessment and Language, Literacy and Numeracy Assessment. Supporting documentation (e.g. Australian passport or citizenship document, academic transcript, etc.); are viewed and copies retained on file to support the student's application
- 3. The Admissions Officer assesses the application against the entry requirements.
  - a. Where the application is not complete or if further information is required to assess whether the applicant has met the entry requirements for their chosen course, the applicant will be contacted and given the opportunity to provide further information.





- b. Applicants who do not meet the published entry requirements will be sent a letter clearly outlining the reasons why they have not been offered a place in the course. The letter will also advise the unsuccessful applicant about their right to appeal the decision and how to access the appeals process.
- c. Successful applicants will be provided a Letter of Offer. In order to secure a place in the program, students will need to:
  - i. Complete and return the Acceptance portion of the Letter of Offer
  - ii. Submit a signed Enrolment Agreement and Complete AVETMISS Enrolment Form
  - iii. Make arrangements for payment and/ or submit Request for VET Student Loan ecaf.
  - iv. Students will receive a confirmation of enrolment and information for their first day of study.
