

- Lay the power cable so that it cannot be stepped on or pinched. Pay special attention to the plug and the point at which the cable is led out of the television.
- Do not let the power cord hang over the edge of the table.
- Disconnect the TV from the mains if there is a thunderstorm or if it is not used for a long period


Smells from the TV

New TVs can cause unusual smells when they are switched on for the first time.

Due to the manufacturing process of the components, the television and other electronic products may have parts that produce odors when they are first turned on and warmed up. The smell usually disappears after a few days of use and does not return.

This is normal and occurs with many electronic devices. Ensure that there is sufficient ventilation in and around the device so that the smell can disappear.

Earphone Out: Audio output from TV through Earphone

SCART: AV input from a device like VCR

CI Slot: Insert CI card for Digital TV (Not for use in Ireland)

SIGNAL SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Antenna/Satellite Cable Connection

NB. The best Irish Digital Saorview picture and signal quality will be received by using an UHF aerial fitted on the outside of your home.

Areas differ in signal quality strength, it is recommended to contact your local TV & Satellite installition company for best results.

- a. Connect the Plug of your aerial cable to the aerial input **(DVB-T)** to the rear of the TV to receive Irish Digital Saorview TV reception.
- b. Connect the Plug of your Satellite cable to the satellite input (DVB-S) to the rear of the TV to receive Free to air Satellite Channles.

FIRST TIME INSTALLATION

Once your Aerial & Satellite cables are connected power on your TV.

You will see this display.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select the language to be used for menus and message.

Press ENTER to move forward to the next page.







Auto Tuning


The Satellite tuning is first. Please press ENTER when you see the message below.



Next you will get the message below. If you want to save time and obtain a preset list of Satellite channel select YES by pressing ◀. This will take a minute and your channel list will appear.

If you want to tune the satellite channels manually Press NO ▶ to refer further down the user manual for further information on manual tuning and channel

setting.





Next Press the Tuner button on the remote. This will move the TV the Irish Channel area. Now press the Menu button and you will get the message below. Press the ▼to highlight Auto Tuning and press enter.

The TV will now tune Irish Digital channels from the Saroview platform.



Aspect Ratio

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Aspect Ratio, then press **Enter** button to enter sub-menu. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select aspect ratio. (Available options are: Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Zoom1, Zoom2)



Blue Screen





Picture Mode

Personal mode.

TIPS: You can press PMODE button to change the Picture Mode directly



Contrast/ Brightness/ Color/ Tint / Sharpness

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, then press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Contrast Adjust the highlight intensity of the picture, but the shadow of the picture is invariable.

Brightness Adjust the optical fiber output of the entire picture, it will affect dark region of the picture.

Color Adjust the saturation of the picture based on your own liking

Tint Use in compensating color changed with the transmission in the NTSC code.

Sharpness Adjust the peaking in the detail of the picture

Color Temp

Change overall color cast of the picture

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temperature, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temperature. (Available Picture mode: Cold, Normal, Warm).

Change the value of red, green and blue when the color temperature is in User mode



Cold Increase the blue tone for the white.

Normal Set to default color temperature.

Warm Increase the red color for the white

Noise Reduction

Filter out and reduces the image noise to improve picture quality.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Noise Reduction , then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.



Off Select to turn off video noise detection.

Low Detect and reduce low video noise.

Middle Detect and reduce moderate video noise.

High Detect and reduce enhanced video noise.

Default Set as Default.

Sound

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SOUND** in the main menu



Press \P / \blacktriangle button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **SOUND** menu.2. Press **Enter** button to adjust.

After finishing your adjustment, Press **Enter** button to save and return to the previous menu

Sound Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Sound Mode, then press Enter button to enter sub-menu. Press ▼/▲ button to select.



You can change the value of Treble and Bass when the sound is in Personal mode.

TIPS: You can press **SMODE** button on the remote control to change the Sound Mode directly.

Standard Produces a balanced sound in all environments.

Music Preserves the original sound. Good for musical programs.

Movie Enhances treble and bass for a rich sound experience.

Sports Enhances vocals for sports.

Personal Select to customize sound settings

Note: The treble and bass are only available in **Personal** mode, you can adjust them as you like.

Balance

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Auto Volume level

SPDIF Mode

AD Switch




