Recognition Letter regarding Charging Compatibility with OUTLANDER PHEV

1. Purpose of this recognition letter

MITSUBISHI MOTORS CORPORATION (“MMC”) conducted the compatibility test of the charging station described in section 2 (“Charging Station”) with the MITSUBISHI MOTORS Outlander PHEV models described in section 2 (“Outlander PHEV”) in accordance with certain criteria. As the result of such test, MMC conditionally recognizes that the Charging Station is compatible with the Outlander PHEV.

This recognition letter is only effective in case that all of the conditions set forth below are satisfied:

- (1) All modifications to the software and hardware of the Charging Station recommended by MMC are properly implemented on the Charging Station.
- (2) The manufacturer of the Charging Station described in section 2 hereof (“Manufacturer”) keeps MMC informed on any hardware or software modification to be implemented after the compatibility test date described in section 2, provided, however, that the Manufacturer shall inform MMC of such hardware or software modification at least 30 days before the targeted launch date of the modified Charging Station to the market so that MMC may check if the modified Charging Station is compatible with Outlander PHEV.
- (3) The Charging Station properly performs under actual use conditions.
- (4) The Manufacturer promptly advises MMC as soon as the Manufacturer finds any possible problems or safety concern, actual or possible, on the Charging Station such as its incompatibility with Outlander PHEV.
- (5) The Manufacturer proactively cooperates with MMC or other relevant parties in order to solve any charging incidents arising out of or in connection with malfunction of the Charging Stations.

2. Tested Charging Station and Vehicle

The Charging Station, Outlander PHEV and the test facility used for our compatibility test are as follows. Please refer to the attached test report for the detailed result of such test.
