2. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a **sentence** that **tells** something. It **gives information** and **states a fact**. It begins with a **capital letter** and ends with a **period**.
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a **sentence** that **asks** something and requires an **answer**. It begins with a **capital letter** and ends with a **question mark**.
4. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a **sentence** that makes a **request** or tells **you to do something**. It begins with a **capital letter** and usually ends with a **period**.
5. An \_\_\_\_\_ is a **sentence** that **expresses strong feeling** or **emotion**. It begins with a **capital letter** and ends with an **exclamation mark**.
6. A \_\_\_\_\_ **sentence** contains **one independent clause** and at least **one dependent clause** introduced by a **subordinating conjunction**.
