

## 3 Instructions for installation

## 3.1 Positioning (encased ovens)





The company declines any responsibility in the case that the following regulations are not respected.

- 1. The preliminary operation to carry out is that of checking the chimney (proportioned section and length) and its maintained state (it mustn't be dirty or obstructed).
- 2. The oven must have its own chimney which mustn't be used by other pieces of equipment.
- 3. If the chimney is not yet installed it is advisable to mount a round section chimney with a smooth exterior and good insulation.
- 4. The encased oven must be mounted in its definitive place positioning it at the desired height on two simple brick columns of about 12 cm thickness. It is necessary to avoid contact between the metal structures of the oven and cement plastering.
- 5. It is of maximum importance to maintain minimum space of 5 cm at the rear of the oven, vital for adequate airing.
- 6. It is vital to leave in the surrounding, at the height of the chimney of the oven, an opening (minimum 30 x 45 cm) for the maintenance and inspection of the equipment.

## 3.2 Electrical connection

Be sure that the nominal tension of the grid is adapt to the functioning of the oven.

Before carrying out the connection check the efficiency of the equipment at ground level. The setting of the equipment at ground level is obligatory for the law.
