



Top tips to clean your dogs teeth?

In this article, we will cover the importance of dogteeth cleaning and why you need to brush your dog's teeth.

Based on our research and speaking to various vets, it is highly advisable that you clean your dog's teeth regularly as it helps reducing chances of developing gum diseases, also will have loads of benefits including:

- Lower chance of developing gum problems from Tartar, Gingivitis and plaques build-up
- Bad breath and yellow teeth
- Reduced chance of getting life-threatening infections and issues like heart, liver or kidney disease from poor dental hygiene

Our step by step guide to clean your dog's teeth?

- 1. Use a dog toothbrush, chew toy or chew bone
- 2. Only use dog-safe toothpaste and never use human toothpaste or baking soda
- 3. Start slowly by introducing your dog to the tooth brushing process
- 4. Lift your dogs' lip to expose the outside surfaces of gums and teeth
- 5. Brush your dog's teeth with toothbrush or finger brush with gentle motions and move your way from back molars to the front
- 6. Remember to reward your dog with a treat after as part of their positive reinforcement trainings
