#### Guide

#### Level

The bulk of our charts were written for college-level and professional bands and are typically published "as recorded". It is therefore important to note that our level classification system differs from some publishers in that nearly all the music is at the higher grade levels. We use the following guidelines:

**Easy** — roughly a grade  $3\frac{1}{2}$  level chart, playable by a moderately experienced band. Tempos and ranges are typically reasonable. **Medium** — roughly a grade 4-5 chart for experienced bands. May be more complex, and ranges & tempos may be more difficult. **Advanced** — roughly a grade 5 or 5+ chart, intended for advanced / pro bands. Can sometimes be quite challenging & demanding.

#### Instrumentation

At the end of each description, the required instrumentation is specified. For the big band charts, an abbreviated system of numbers is used, that denotes the necessary number of saxes, trumpets, trombones & rhythm players. For example: (5,4,4,4) indicates a band of 5 saxophones, 4 trumpets, 4 trombones, & 4 rhythm section players. Optional and additional instruments are also specified.
