A sure-footed personality. A gentle soul. A good friend that works well with others, yet might not always think for themselves. Such a person feels best when following the crowd.



## XI. MUMMUSSA

A caring provider. A vigilant protector. A nurturing teacher. A compassionate boss. Someone who you can rely on when feeling most vulnerable.



### XII. GALUGAFUS

### XVII. CORDOCOVIAN
