Upright Meaning:

Upright Meaning:

A frugal female figure. Someone of high social status and class. Abundant wealth and opulence. Luxury. Love through discipline.

Reversed Meaning:

A cruel mother. Greed. Denying help or service to someone in need. A shallow or materialistic individual.



KNIGHT OF COINS

The sleepy knight wakes with a wide yawn while his dragon still slumbers. In the distance, the city is ablaze and in dire need of assistance. Unfortunately, the only way to motivate the lazy knight to take action is by lowering a valuable incentive from the heavens.

Upright Meaning:

Someone slow to act. Not recognizing an emergency. Wasting time. A boring routine. Mundane surroundings. A bribe.

Reversed Meaning:

Irresponsibility. Not taking things seriously. An unreliable person. Lethargy.



PAGE OF COINS

The young page races after a winged coin in hopes of capture. Although he keeps a steady eye on his prize, he fails to notice the stream of water crossing his path. If he is not careful to pay attention, he will likely fall in and drown.

Upright Meaning:

Chasing a financial opportunity. Big money dreams. Ambition. The optimistic start of a new business venture. Financial nievity.

Reversed Meaning:

Financial folly. The pursuit of money over fulfillment. Procrastination. Letting a financial opportunity pass you by.



TEN OF COINS

Upright Meaning:

Material accomplishments. Affluence. Generational wealth. Inheritance. Privilege. Enduring success.

Reversed Meaning:

Bankruptcy. Colossal debts. Financial ruin. End of a legacy. Illegal financial activity.



NINE OF COINS

Upright Meaning:

A luxurious lifestyle. Financial security and independence. Prosperity. Abundance. Enjoying the fruits of one's labor. A sophisticated person.

Reversed Meaning:

Financial dependence. Getting into debt. Leeching off the system. Dishonest money.



EIGHT OF COINS

Upright Meaning:

Apprenticeship. Learning a trade. Developing valuable skills. Working towards mastery. Quality. Dedication to a craft. Steady productivity.

Reversed Meaning:

Mundane work. Poor effort. Lack of focus. Sub-par quality. Rushed work. Slow productivity.



SEVEN OF COINS

Upright Meaning:

Investing in yourself. Having patience with one's work. Measuring progress. Giving yourself time to grow.

Reversed Meaning:

Shortsighted expectations. Impatience. Leaving projects unfinished. Lack of motivation. Frustration.

Reversed Meaning:

Reversed Meaning:

Reversed Meaning:

Reversed Meaning:

Balancing responsibilities. Adaptation to changing circumstances. Partnerships. Financial booms and busts. Rhythmic cycles.

Reversed Meaning:

An unbalanced life. Financial overwhelm. An unorganized person. Not being able to handle responsibilities.



ACE OF COINS

Upright Meaning:

An amazing financial opportunity. Prosperity. Manifestation of material abundance. Financial security.

Reversed Meaning:

Missing a golden opportunity. Lack of financial discipline. Scarcity. Running out of capital. Poor monetary strategies.

I. The Winged Ones

A peasant flees in terror as a flock of winged demons give chase through the valley. Relentless in their pursuit of blood, the demons will stop at nothing to obtain a bit of flesh.

Upright:

Persistent annoyances. Harsh realities demand your attention. Fear or avoidance of problems that won't go away by themselves.

Reversed:

Things don't bother you as much as they used to. At this time, you may be able to handle multiple problems with courage.



II. The Sea Goddess

The bold Sea Goddess slithers atop the waves seeking to explore uncharted realms. Propelled by self-confidence, she knows her potential is as boundless as the vast ocean lying ahead.

Upright:

Expansion. Living to capacity. Adventure. Conquest.

Reversed:

Retreat. Lack of confidence. Limited thinking.



III. The Lioness

The heroic Lioness offers a full chalice to a thirsty world. Through steadfast determination, she was able to collect her drink from an oasis few have dared venture to.

Upright:

Achieving a difficult, yet worthy goal. Doing what's necessary for success despite the opinions of others. Conviction. Staying focused.

Reversed:

Failure to obtain an objective. Letting criticism thwart your ambitions. Felling unworthy of success.



IV. The Flutist

The Flutist plays a sweet melody on a glorious Spring day. His tune captivates a trio of flying creatures that hover in delight to the magical vibrations of the music.

Upright:

Using one's skills and talents to attract all they desire. Fame. Recognition. The rewards of hard work and practice realized.

Reversed:

Behavior that attracts the wrong things in life. Negative attention. Wasting or misusing one's potential.



V. The Interloper

A treacherous demon attempts to blend in with a trio of devout angels. Although the demon vows to behave, his presence within the group will undoubtedly undermine their righteous efforts.

Upright:

A fake friend. Trouble in disguise. Overlooking an obvious problem to keep up appearances.

Reversed:

An imposter or traitor exposed. Time to rid your party of a detrimental personality.



VI. The Jester

A four-armed jester joyfully acts out the dramas of life in his garden. Though the puppets he controls are serious characters, his playful demeanor reminds us to take the days problems in stride and laugh at it all.

Upright:

Levity. Having a sense of humor. Taking a light-hearted approach to a daunting situation.

Reversed:

Acting mature. Time to get serious. Stop fooling around. No more games.



VII. The Maiden

A hooded maiden holds a small pet in her palm, gazing into its eyes with devotion. In time, the tiny creature will grow gigantic and powerful, but until then it is dependent on the young girl for its every need. The maiden protects the creature against negative influences by keeping the darker side of life (represented by her devilish hood) turned away.

Upright:

Nurturing something vulnerable. Custodianship. Responsibilities. Being someone's role model. Having someone to look up to.

Reversed:

Setting poor examples. Irresponsibility. Neglect. Abandonment.



VIII. The Doppelganger

A small child dressed as a demon pries open the mouth of a fierce lion. To his surprise, he discovers a mirror image of himself gazing back from inside.

Upright:

Introspection. Seeking to improve oneself. Discovering and recognizing your innate potential. Adopting new identities and shedding old ones. Looking for courage within.

Reversed:

Being unable to face yourself. Feelings of worthlessness. Unrecognized abilities.



IX. Naughty Demons

Three demons meekly approach the reprimand of Justice. Truly remorseful for their misdeeds, the submissive demons hope for forgiveness as they prepare to accept the deserved punishment to come.

Upright:

Atonement. Making amends. Facing consequences. Obedience. Knowing one's place.

Reversed:

Unpunished sins. The unwillingness to admit a wrongdoing. Disobedience or defiance.



X. The Bluebirds

A flock of beautiful bluebirds return home after being gone for so long. The sight of them gliding carefree among the stars is a blessed relief for all the weary souls below.

Upright:

A golden age after a dark period. Getting back on track. A second wind. Revitalization. The tides are turning in your favor.

Reversed:

Loss. Going downhill. A brief spell of misfortune. Situations seem to be worsening.

XVI. THE LIGHTNING

A shepherd gasps in shock as bolts of lightning flash from the sky, setting a tree ablaze. Flames fill the air, as his frightened flock scatters in terror.

Upright Meaning:

Unexpected devastation. An uncontrollable tragic event. True authority exerting its power over the masses. Being helpless and at the mercy of a catastrophoc situation.

Reversed Meaning:

Realizing you are more powerful then you have been led to believe. Coming together to overcome tragedy. Composing one's wits to deal with a calamity.



XVII. THE STAR

As earthly creatures devour her body, a desperate woman pleads to the heavens for salvation. Without warning, a radiant star appears in the sky, offering her hope in troubles times.

Upright Meaning:

Hope. Waiting for a wish to come true. A promise from a higher source. A bright outlook. A belief that things will soon get better.

Reversed Meaning:

Not recognizing a hopeful sign. Pessimisms. Surrendering without a fight. Letting life get the best of you.



XX. JUDGMENT

The mouth of Hell opens wide to ingest the souls of evil doers. Three terrified citizens shiver and pray as fire engulfs their wretched bodies. Once the mouth closes, the trio will be trapped in eternal misery and pain.

Upright Meaning:

Damnation. Paying a high but deserved price for wrong doings. A final verdict. Extreme punishment.

Reversed Meaning:

Leniency. Forgiveness. Getting a second chance. Realizing and rectifying one's mistakes before it's too late.
