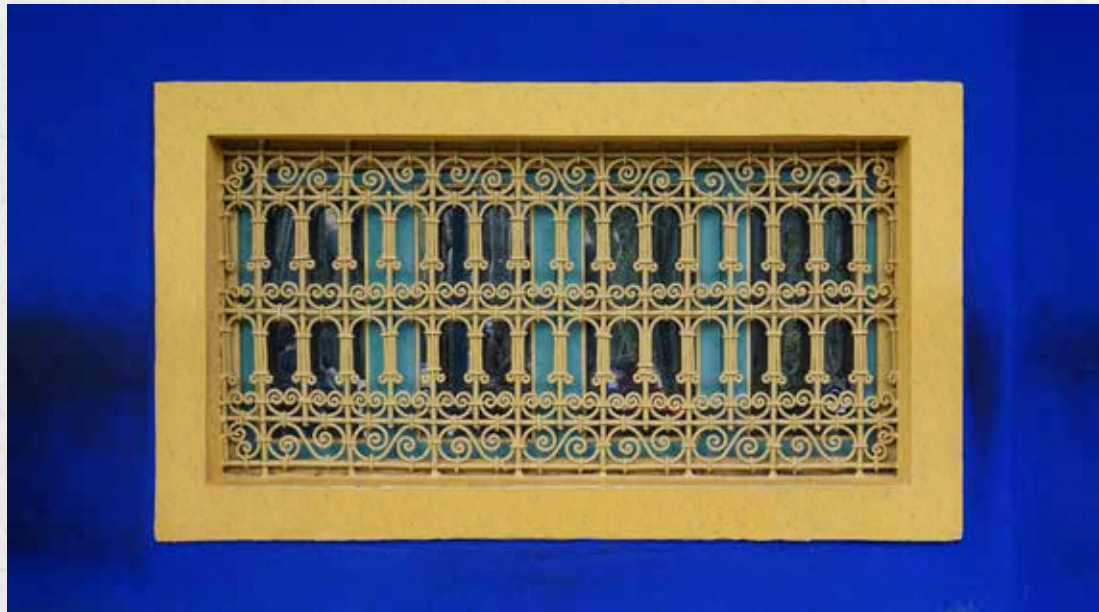
FRIDAY

10 MAY


Jardin Majorelle & YSL Museum

DAY 06



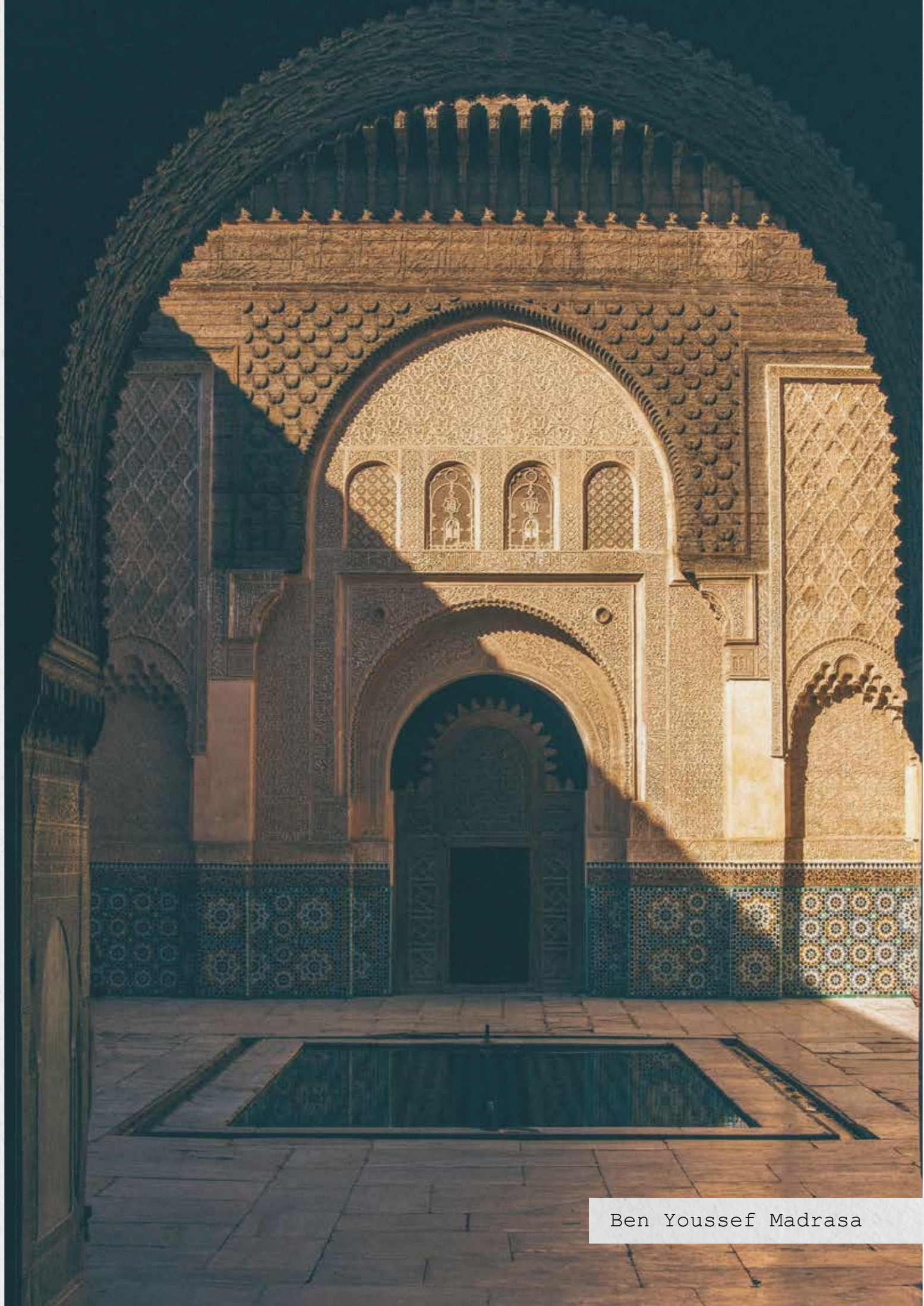


SUNDAY 12 MAY



GENERAL * INFORMATION

TRAVEL DATES: 1st May 2024 - 8th May 2024

TOTAL COST: \$9900 (excluding flights) however the \$1500 non refundable deposit must be paid in order to secure your spot!

INCLUSIONS: **Airport transfer, twin share accommodation, all meals and drinks, activities and entry into sites and museums.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To secure your spot you must pay a non refundable deposit of \$1500. The remainder of the payment is due 29th of March 2024 or prior. This payment will not be able to be refunded after 29th of March 2024.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LANGUAGE: In Marrakech, you'll hear a flurry of languages including French, Spanish, Arabic, and Berber. English is common anywhere touristy, but it's definitely handy to know a few words of French.

CURRENCY and MONEY: Morocco uses dirhams, and one Australian dollar will get you about 7MAD. When it comes to spending money, you will only need cash in the markets and be prepared to haggle with vendors (we will help guide you on this).

Please note you can legally only bring in 2000MAD cash (roughly \$300AUD). You will only need cash for purchases in the markets. We will visit an ATM as a group daily.

Contact your bank prior to leaving to avoid blockage of accounts .

Negotiate any taxi ride fees prior to getting in. Ask your riad for assist.

Should you require extra services (such as personal shopping pick ups out of hours) very minimum additional fees apply.

Morocco is a 'tipping' country . **We cover ALL tips for all accom/food etc but suggest an optional tip for our personal driver/guide should you wish to contribute (not essential but appreciated).**

ALCOHOL: Whilst this is a Muslim country, alcohol is served at selected bars and restaurants. All drinks are included in meals on the tour however if you should wish for a pre dinner drink, we advise you bring a bottle of spirits in duty free as alcohol is quite a bit more expensive in Morocco and not readily available to purchase.

CLIMATE: Marrakech is warm all year. Average temps in May range from lows of 15° and highs of 29°. It is a dry desert heat and remember to pack a hat and sun protection for your travels.

SHOPPING and SHIPPING: Marrakech in particular is an extremely welcoming city to tourists that being said, the vendors in the markets are looking to make money and can spot tourist from a mile away. If there's something you like be prepared to haggle for the price. If people are shouting out to get your attention, it may feel rude at first but just keep walking past and ignoring them if you're not interested. Don't worry, you can always loop back and pick something up from them if you want later on. We will always give you time to come back later and purchase things, you don't have to commit right away.

Shipping of all purchases is possible worldwide/you don't have to fit it all in your suitcase! This will be costed at DHL post purchase and managed by our guide.

The markets are very full on, please be wary of your movements and pay attention. You'll often have mopeds, scooters and even donkey karts whizzing right by you, with little chance on them slowing down. Don't worry, just be aware. And stand to one side of the path when walking.

Travelling alone? Don't worry, you're about to make a lot of new friends in our little group but we can also get you in touch with other people in the group that may be travelling from where you reside so you can tee up flights together. The rooms will also be twin share so we'll pair you up if you're travelling solo.

GETTING * THERE

The flight from Australia to Marrakech isn't a quick one but it's worth every minute to get there. It can take around 30 hours depending on how long your layover is and the route you take. Often flights from Australia will have one transfer at Casablanca (yes THAT Casablanca) Airport and is only a 1 hour flight.

Australian passport holders do not need a visa to get into Marrakech. Upon immigration at the airport, please note the below if asked for accomodation information. Also hold onto your boarding pass for security.

There's a few levels of security including one final scan of your luggage and carry on after baggage claim. After you finally get through immigration and out the airport, we will have private transfer waiting for you to take you to the riad with the pool ready for you to dip your toes in! Just look for the sign saying.

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The tour officially kicks off at 4pm poolside on the 1st May. You may have room access from 2pm. Should you arrive earlier you are welcome to leave bags at riad.

PACKING * SUGGESTIONS

CLOTHING and OUTFITS: Whilst Morocco is a Muslim country, they are very welcoming of tourists so when dressing for the trip, you can wear bare arms and shorts skirts or dresses but still be considerate of the culture. If visiting a place of worship or historic site it's advised to cover up.

Bring lots of colour in your outfits, trust us, the photos will look incredible! We've had guests in everything from gold jumpsuits to hot pink marabou feather trimmed trousers, and that's just on the camel ride! ***Also bring a nice outfit for our final dinner, we like to get dressed up.***

ESSENTIALS and MEDICATION: We advise you pack all your essential toiletries and medication necessary when travelling. We will have antiseptic creams, wipes and a basic first aid kit on hand however it's suggested you bring antibiotics and/or cold and flu in case you do fall ill whilst travelling.

We also suggest you are up to date on vaccinations for COVID and tetanus however this is not mandatory for travel.



COVID-19 TRAVEL POLICY

This policy is correct as at 21st of May 2023 and will be updated as relevant government policies change. Note COVID vaccination and testing requirements vary from country to country and are constantly changing. We will provide the latest COVID-19 entry and testing requirements relating to individual tours much closer to departure dates. This policy should be read in conjunction with our Terms and Conditions. These can be viewed above.

Vaccination

It is suggested for you to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 with a vaccine approved by the Australian Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA). This is so we can provide a safe environment (by mitigating health risks) for our guides, our suppliers and their staff, and our other customers. It also assists to protect the communities you will visit. It is your responsibility to obtain vaccinations and preventative medicines as may be required for the duration of the trip. Any information provided by us is given in good faith.

What happens if someone on a trip shows symptoms of COVID-19?

If someone on your trip has symptoms of COVID-19, they will be required to undergo a COVID-19 test and return a negative test result in order to remain on the trip.

What happens if you or someone else tests positive to COVID-19 on a trip?

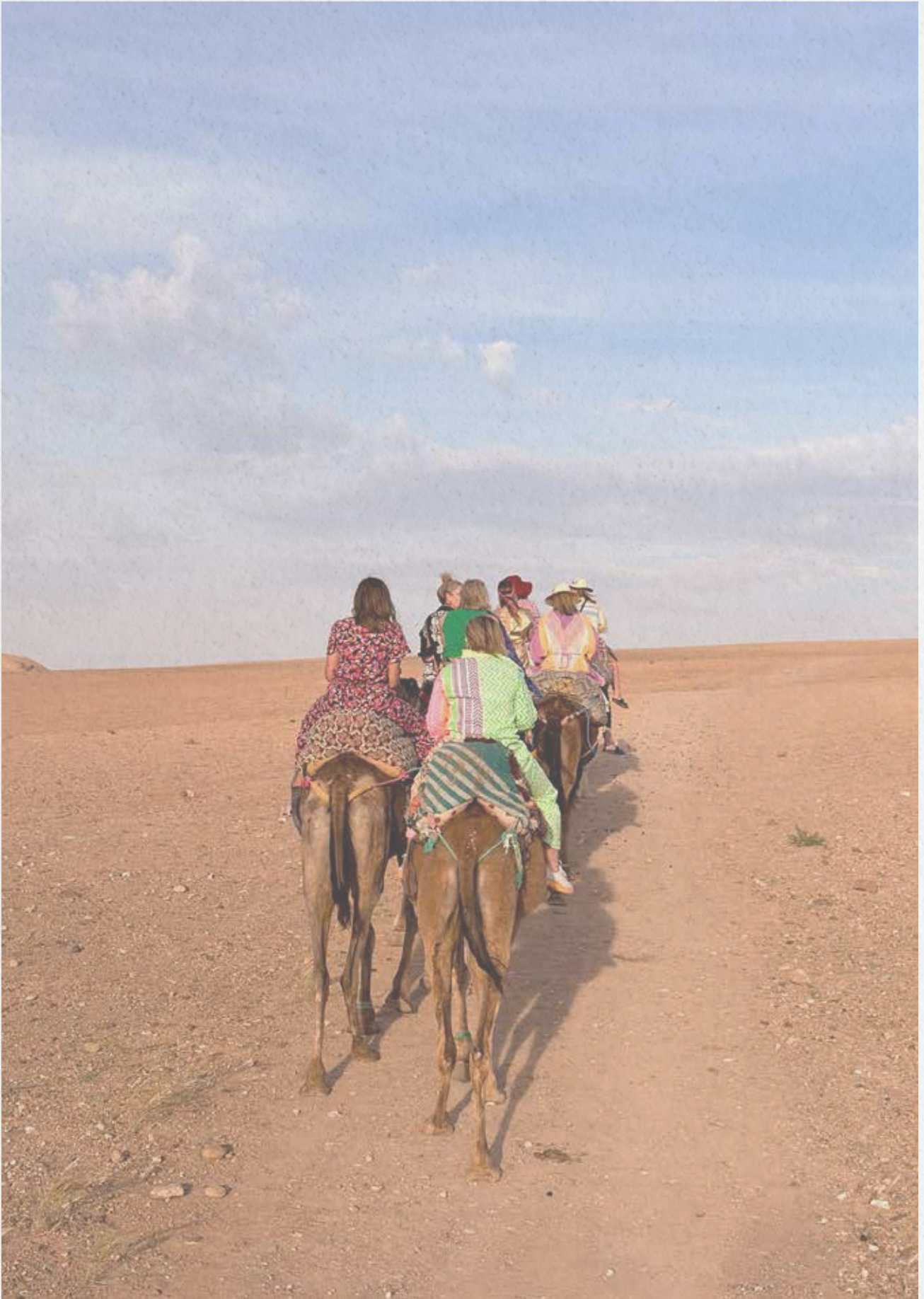
If someone tests positive to COVID-19 on a trip, Julia Green or Jono Fleming, will manage this as a health and safety incident. The person who has tested positive will need to leave the trip for the health and safety of themselves and others. They will be assisted to access further testing or medical treatment if needed, and assisted to isolate or enter hotel quarantine or isolation, if required by local regulations. Any costs associated with isolation, medical treatment, transport to and from medical facilities etc will be the sole responsibility of the traveller. Please retain all receipts for these costs as they will be important when making your travel insurance claim. We will assist with translation services, contacting insurance companies, travel agents and/or airlines as required. The rest of the group will need to undergo COVID-19 testing and return a negative result before being able to continue on the trip.

If you're required to take a test while on a trip, do you have to pay for it?

We will bring plenty of rapid tests to cater for the group however, you should be prepared to purchase tests, if required. Costs for tests vary, depending on the destination. Please ensure you have access to funds in case of this or other emergencies.

Travel Insurance

Comprehensive travel insurance is suggested for all travellers. Please ensure that the policy you choose has cover for COVID-19 events including prior to departure eg. if you need to cancel your booking due to testing positive to COVID-19, or on-tour e.g. you test positive to COVID-19 and cannot continue.
