# Holiday Sparkle Collection Christmas Wallhanging

## <u>Supplies</u>

Christmas Fabric 22" square Decorative backing fabiric Backing fabric 22" square 1 1/2" strips of fabric for 95" of binging Fusible batting 22" square Background fabric for 9 applique squares 5" by 5" Fusible batting 22" square Assortment of Rayon thread in Christmas Colors Top Stitch 80 needle Steam-A-Seam or other paper backed adhesive Tear Easy Stabilizer Adhesive spray Regular sewing supplies, ruler, blue wash away marker, pins etc.



### Preparation:

- 1. Fuse the Decorative fabric to the batting.
- 2. Stitch the binding strips together with a bias seam to make 95" of binding.
- 3. Fold in half length wise to have a long strip that is 1 1/2" wide.
- 4. Fuse backing fabric to the back of the batting with adhesive spray.
- 5. Cut 9 squares 5 1/2" square for the appliqués.
- 6. Hoop stabilizer in hoop.
- 7. Download 9 of the applique designs.

### Embroidery:

- 1. Hoop stabilizer in the hoop.
- 2. Stitch the applique designs according to the Stitching Instructions included in the file.

#### Construction:

- 1. Gently tear or cut the appliqués from the paper stabilizer.
- 2. Stick paper backed adhesive to the back on the appliqués.
- 3. Measure down 2" from the top.
- 4. Starting from the top place the appliqués 2" from the top of the fabric and 1" apart as in the picture.

- 5. Trim the fabric sandwich to be 2" from the appliqués on all 4 sides. The wall hanging should be about 20" square .
- 6. Stitch the appliques down by stitching close to the satin stitching.
- 7. Attach the binding in your favorite method.
