

- 1. This Brooklyn Dodgers catcher's career was cut short after an automobile accident left him paralyzed in 1958. (nickname)
- 2. Nicknamed "Stan The Man"
- 3. This Red Sox hitter was the last MLB player to hit over .400 and was known as the "Splendid Splinter"
- 4. One of the greatest Yankees of all time, he set a record of 2130 consecutive games played earning him the nickname the "Iron Horse"
- 5. This player broke the record set by Across #4
- 6. As an active player who had over 3000 hits, he died in a plane crash supplying earthquake relief aid to Nicaraqua
- 7. This quy was the first to surpass Babe Ruth's career homerun record
- 8. This Cleveland Indians pitcher started in the Negro Leagues and made his first start in MLB at the age of 42 $\,$

- 10. The first Canadian elected to the Hall of Fame
- 11. This Dodger pitcher dominated until his career was cut short because of arthritis
