- 1 point for any bag that comes to rest anywhere on top of the board
- 3 points for any bag that is tossed through the hole or knocked through the hole by another bag
- Foul Bags are any bag that has not been tossed from the pitcher's box or came into contact with the ground before landing on the board

The player/team who scored in the preceding inning has the honor of pitching first in the next inning. If neither player/team scores, the player/team who pitched first in the preceding inning shall retain first toss in the next inning.

WINNING THE GAME:

The first player/team to reach exactly 21 points wins. If a team goes over 21 points, their score goes down to 10 and play resumes.






8 – All-Weather Duck Cloth Bags w/ Carrying Satchel

GAME SETUP:

According to the American Cornhole Association (ACA), the below dimensions and measurements apply.

The court shall be a level rectangular area 8-10 feet wide and a minimum of 40-45 feet long as shown below.



The pitcher's box is a 4x3 ft rectangle that each player must remain in while tossing a cornhole bag.

HOW TO PLAY:

According to ACA, every match is broken down into innings. To complete an inning, each player must pitch all four of their bags.

CORNHOLE



SINGLES:

Both players stay in their lanes for the complete match (Team A and Team B as shown in the previous diagram). Players start the game at the same board in their own pitcher's box.

Players then toss their bags at the board across the court alternating tosses until each player has tossed all their bags.

Then, players walk to the other side of the court in their lane, take score, and resume tossing bags back to the other board.

DOUBLES:

Two teams, consisting of two players will stay in their designated lane for the whole game. Each player stays in their designated pitcher's box the entire game.

Players start the game by tossing from the same board across the court alternating tosses until each team has tossed all their bags.

Players at the other side of the court will then take score and resume tossing bags back to the other board.

SCORING:

The ACA method of scoring is "cancellation" scoring. The points of one player/team cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each inning.
