## **HOW TO PLAY SHUFFLEBOARD:**

Teams consist of 1-2 players. One player from each team stands on the same side of the board with all stones on this side.

Flip a coin to determine who goes first.

Players slide the stones alternatively. Stones must cross the line at the point of the triangle to be in play. Stones that do not cross this line are removed.

## SCORING:

Scoring occurs once all 8 stones have been played and is according to the numbers marked in the target area. Stones must be completely inside a marked area to count for points. Anything touching a line scores nothing. Stones completely in the 10 OFF area is negative 10 points.

# **WINNING THE GAME:**

The first Team to reach 75 points wins.

# **HOW TO PLAY ENGLISH SHUFFLEBOARD:**

Played the same as Shuffleboard, but use the 1, 2, and 3 scoring zones. First Team to 11 points wins.

# **USE AND CARE:**

YardGames.com Curling / Shuffleboard sets are made with unfinished wood and are not water proof.

To prevent damage and wear, store the game indoors in a dry area.

# CURLING / SHUFFLEBOARD




## **SET INCLUDES:**



1 X Shuffleboard/ Curling Board

8 X Stones (4 blue, 4 red)



## **HOW TO PLAY CURLING:**

Teams consist of 1-2 players. One player from each team stands on the same side of the board with all stones on this side.

The game is played in 8 ends. An end is complete when each team has slid all of their stones across the board.

Flip a coin to decide who gets the hammer. The hammer is the final shot of each end. So, the winning team of the coin toss goes second.


Example: Blue Team wins the coin toss.

Red Team slides their first stone across the board from behind the Hog Line. The stones must pass the other Hog Line to be in play. If it does not pass the Hog Line it is removed from play.

Next, Blue Team slides their first stone across the board, then Red Team and play continues until all the stones have been slid across the board and the end is complete.

### SCORING:

Points are awarded for the stones closest to the center of the target (like bocce). Only one team scores in each end.



Blue Team is awarded one point for the first end and play continues to the next end. Since Blue Team scored the previous end, they slide first for the next end. If no team had scored, the same team that slid first the previous end would slide first the next end.

Next, Blue Team slides their first stone to begin the second end from the other side. If playing with 2-Player teams, Player 2 will slide the second end. Then, Red Team Player 2 slides, etc. until the end is complete.

Play continues for 8 ends.

## **WINNING THE GAME:**

After 8 ends, the Team with the higher score wins.

If play is tied after 8 ends, then each team selects a Player to shoot one stone to try and get as close to the center of the target as possible. Each Team gets one shot and the Team that gets closest wins (After the first stone is throw it is measured and removed for the next Team's stone)
