Artist's Notebook

Consider stippling in the cheeks. Wet the very tips of the brush bristles with White (5) then slightly press the bristles straight down onto the surface, leaving small paint dots. Concentrate more dots to make the white bolder and fade the edges using less dots.

Painting Instructions

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint chest and side pockets with Smoke Gray (28).
- 3. Paint head, back and rump using Timber Brown (34).
- 4. Paint the bill Blue Gray (29).
- 5. Draw in the cheek patches and paint with White (2).
