Artist's Notebook

The dry brush technique means to slightly wet the tip of the brush then remove most of the paint on a scrap. With a "dry" brush, lightly brush the surface of the head to leave a shaded effect. Consider using this technique to apply Cedar Brown (10) to the cheeks as well.

Painting Instructions

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint the back and side pockets White (2) and the chest and rump Black (5)
- 3. Paint the head Burnt Sienna (63).
- 4. Use dry brush technique to lightly apply Black (5) to the top of head.
- 5. Paint bill Black (5).
