## Artist's Notebook

All shading on cheeks, top of head, and chest should be done very lightly. Less is more. More paint can be applied but it is much more difficult to remove.

## Painting Instructions

1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
2. Mix small amount of (10) and (18) in 1:3 ratio. Paint head chest and sides.
3. Paint top and underside of rump with White (2) and back with Black (5).
4. Paint underside of chin and neck Ivory (25). Dry brush cheeks with (25).
5. Use dry brush technique to lightly shade top of head with (5).
6. Using small fan brush apply Cedar Brown (10) with tip of brush to suggest feathers.
7. Use ½" flat brush to apply White side pocket strips. Stripes do not need to be solid.
