Artist's Notebook Stippling is created by applying a small amount of paint to the tips of the brush bristles. Then lightly dab the surface with the brush completely vertical.

> This creates a shaded effect.

Painting Instructions

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- Paint the entire decoy using Bison Brown (4).
- Paint the small dots on the head using White (2).
- With a small old brush, stipple in some White (2) shading towards the front of the head.
- 5. Paint the bill Blue Gray (29) and while still wet, shade in some Slate Blue (60)
