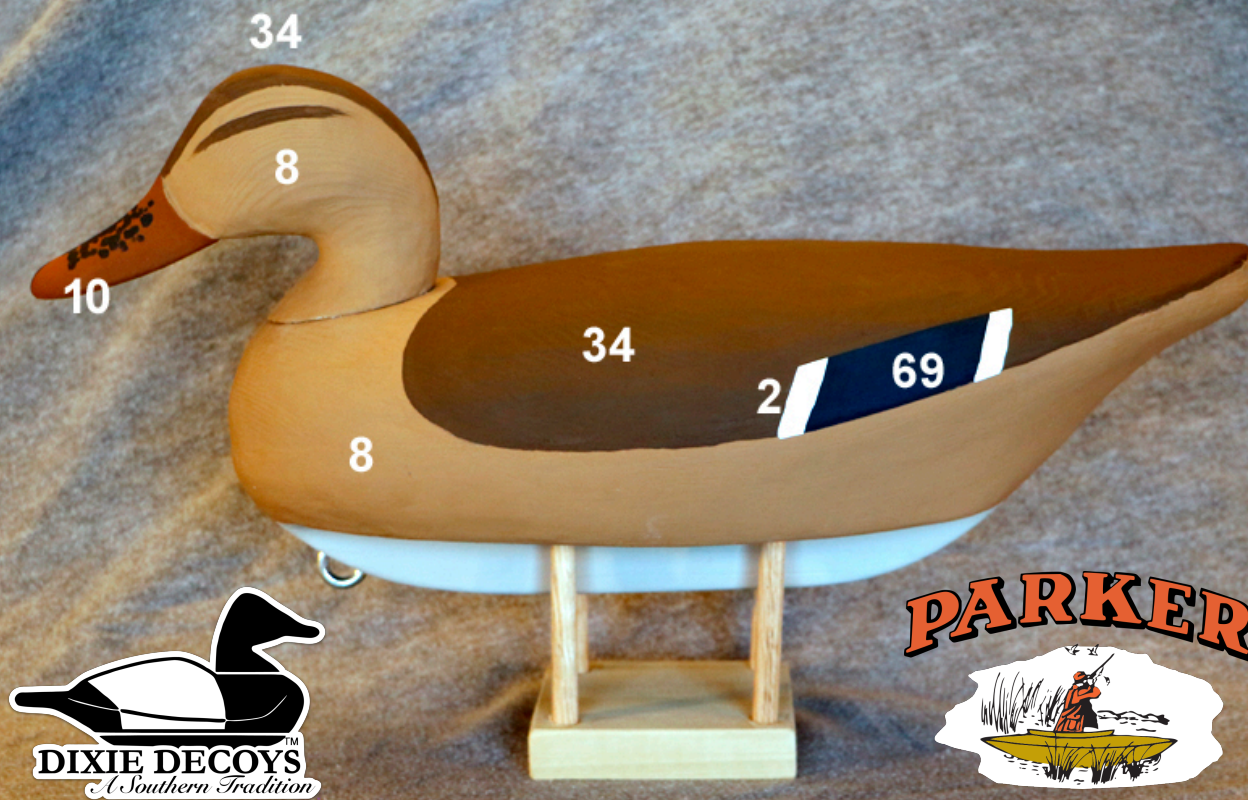


Mallard Hen

34	Timber Brown	
69	Royal Blue	

Artist's Notebook

Consider painting the entire body Tan then applying Timber Brown over the back. While the back is still wet use your brush to simulate feathers from the lighter Tan underneath.

Painting Instructions

1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
2. Paint the head, chest, side pockets, and rump with Tan (8).
3. Paint the back, tail, crown of the head, and eye strip with Timber Brown (34).
4. Use Cedar Brown (10) to dot the bill, or paint a solid stripe.
5. Use painter's tape to paint the speculum with White (2) and Royal Blue (69).
