Artist's Notebook

The Old Squaw paint patterns can be easily transferred to the Heritage Series Puddle Duck body and Widgeon Head to achieve a higher tail.

Painting Instructions

1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
2. Paint the head, lower side pockets and rump White (2).
3. Paint the top shoulder patches Smoke Gray (28).
4. Paint the chest and tail Black (5).
5. Paint the back wing secondaries Redwood Brown (37).
6. Paint the main wing patches Brown (3). Touch up the light wing patches as needed.
7. Paint the upper cheek Taupe (21) and the lower cheek Redwood Brown (37). Paint the center with Brown (3).
8. Mix small amount of White (2) and Redwood Brown (37) to create coral color; paint center of bill.
9. Paint base and tip of bill using Black (5).
