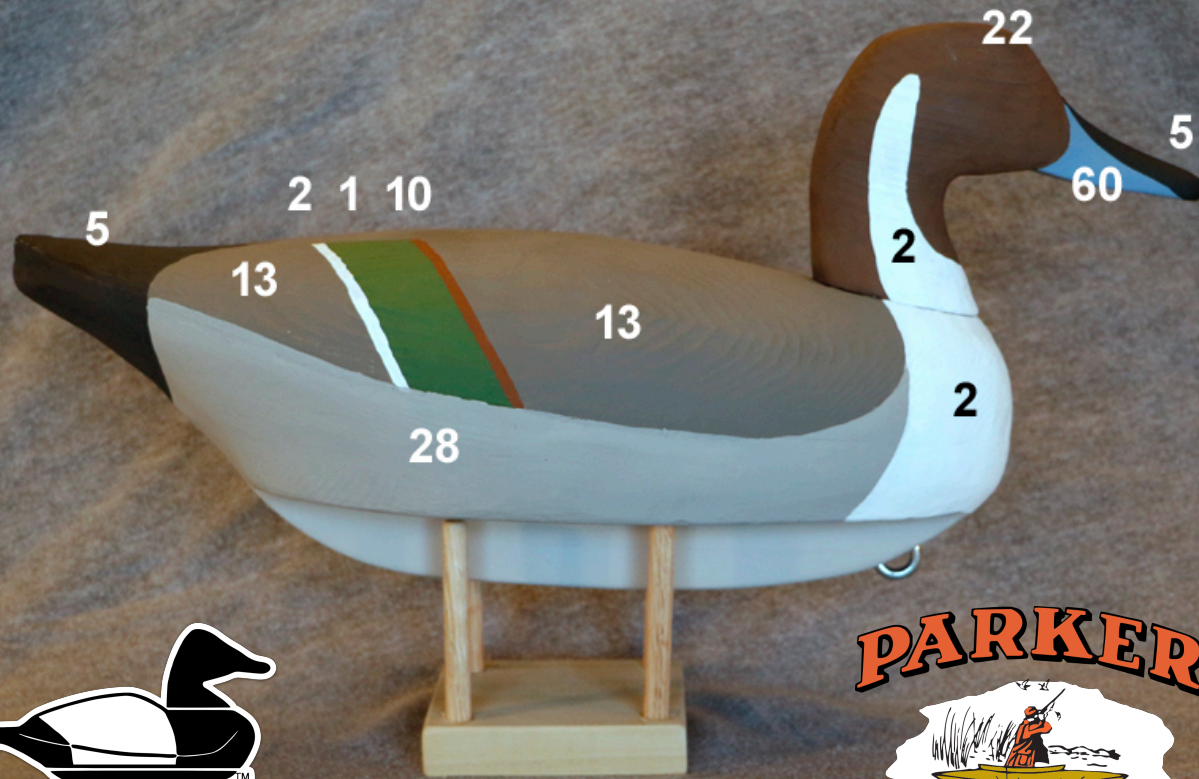


Pintail Drake

Artist's Notebook

Many old decoys used dots of of copper and green instead of lines.

Painting Instructions

1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
2. Paint the lower side pockets Smoke Gray (28).
3. Paint the back and upper wings Medium Gray (13) and the tail/rump Black (5)
4. Paint the head Oak Brown (22).
5. Paint the neck stripe and chest White (2).
6. Paint the bill Slate Blue (60) and let dry. Apply single Black (5) strip down the center of the bill.
7. Paint in the speculum with the pattern of your choice applying White (2), Green (1), and Cedar Brown (10) in order.
