## **Artist's Notebook**

Many old decoys used dots of of copper and green instead of lines.

## **Painting Instructions**

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint the lower side pockets Smoke Gray (28).
- 3. Paint the back and upper wings Medium Gray (13) and the tail/rump Black (5)
- 4. Paint the head Oak Brown (22).
- 5. Paint the neck stripe and chest White (2).
- 6. Paint the bill Slate Blue (60) and let dry. Apply single Black (5) strip down the center of the bill.
- 7. Paint in the speculum with the pattern of your choice applying White (2), Green (1), and Cedar Brown (10) in order.
