Artist's Notebook

Consider using Medium Gray (13) on some hens and Smoke Gray (28) on others to create natural variation in your rig. Timber Brown (34) is also a good substitute for Hen Brown (65).

Painting Instructions

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint the back, sides, and bill with Smoke Gray (28)
- 3. Paint the chest, tail, and head Hen Brown (65).
- 4. Paint in thin White (2) stripe approx. 1/3 up the bill. Finish end of bill with (5).
