Artist's Notebook

There are many lines to contend with. Be sure to plan your layout before you begin to paint.

Painting Instructions

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint the side pockets and chest with Widgeon Brown (62).
- 3. Paint the back with Medium Gray (13).
- 4. Use White (2) to paint the rump, wing patches, and top of head.
- 5. Finish the speculum with Green (1).
- 6. Paint the tail Black (5), then using a small round brush, line the green speculum.
- 7. Paint the lower head and neck with Tan (8) or Ground Color (20). Finish with Green (1).
- 8. Paint the bill Slate Blue (60) and once dry, paint the tip of the bill with Black (5).
