## **Artist's Notebook**

Try creating slight variations in color and pattern to add realism to your spread. No two ducks are exactly the same.

## **Painting Instructions**

- 1. Prep the entire decoy in accordance with the decoy painting instructions, prime with gray Parker Decoy Primer. Draw lines using a pencil.
- 2. Paint the side pockets with Widgeon Brown (62).
- 3. Paint the wings and back with Light Brown (14).
- 4. Paint the head, chest, and rump with River Bottom (30).
- 5. Paint the tail Black (5) and top of the head with Light Brown (14).
- 6. Paint the bill Slate Blue (60) and once dry, paint the tip with Black (5).
