Statement of suitability

Please be advised that the Wire Industrial & Marine BMST-1632 swage tool is machined & assembled in Australia by Dolphin Marine from imported components.

The jaws are made of high carbon cast steel & are hardened to 42 Rockwell. The hardening and chemical blackening process is completed by R J Heat Treatment at Moorebank in Western Sydney.

The machining & assembly is completed by Dolphin Marine near Brookvale in Sydney.

The small hole in the tool is used for 1.6 & 2mm swages, middle hole for 2.4mm swages & the 3rd large hole for 3.2mm (1/8") The adjusting screw on the top of the jaws allows for adjustment to keep the jaws within tolerance for complete & proper swaging.

The tools can press copper & alloy swages only & are not able to press stainless steel ferrules & or terminal fittings.

Each tool :-

- Weighs 5.5kg
- 520mm long

N.B. Hand swaging is NOT suitable for any application where personal safety is <u>a consideration!</u>
