






#### **INSTALLATION ON USING "L" BRACKET**

#### IMPORTANT NOTE:

The (3) "L" shaped brackets that are included with your 270-awning are designed to suit the majority of roof racks / roof bars. There's a rare chance that your particular vehicle-rack setup may require the inclusion of additional pieces.

Be sure to isntall with at least (3) brackets to ensure the free-standing awning is fully supported.



### **INSTALLATION ON USING "U" BRACKET**

#### IMPORTANT NOTE:

The FSR "U" shaped brackets that are available for purchase are designed to suit FSR harshell rooftop tent side mounting channels.

Be sure to isntall with at least (3) brackets to ensure the free-standing awning is fully supported.

1. Remove Rubber Channel Cap

2. Slide (1) T-Slot nut into each half of the tent's bottom channel.

- 3. Place bracket over first T-slot nut and screw in the bolt with a locking washer.
- 4. Repeat for the second bolt. (ensure bolts are not tightetned all the way as you will have to move the bracket to adjust the width.
- Repeat 3-4 for the additional brackets.minimum.

## **INSTALLATION ON USING "U" BRACKET**

6 Slide brackets to evenly space them
across a length as near as possible
to the length of the awning.

7. Tighten all bolts, locking the brackets in place.

8. Insert bolts into the awning's channels, approximating the space needed.

9. Lift awning with bolts up toward brackets, and affix with nuts provided.

## **DEPLOYMENT**

half of the bag over the back of the awning to prevent it from getting caught in the pivot poitns
2. Undo the Velcro straps and unroll the awning.
3. Using the tension strap, carefully pull the awning around your vehicle, to the opposite side.
4. Hook your tension strap to your RTT or rack then tighten the thumb buckle. Do not over-tighten.

5. Flip up the leg on the second awning arm

to tighten up the awning material.

1. Unzip the PVC cover and flip the front
