My mouth hung *agape* as the **love** of my life walked down the aisle.

Christ's **love** on the cross bridges *a gap[e]* between us and God.

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"For they will inherit the earth." (Matt. 5:5)

*G.E.* stands for **ground** and **earth**.

*GE (General Electric)* knows all about electric **grounds**:  
physical connections to the **earth**.

My friend *Zoe* is full of **life**.

# voice, sound

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"The voice of one crying in the wilderness . . ."  
(Luke 3:4 ESV)

**Sound** test your *microphone*, so that your congregation can hear your **voice** while you preach.

*Phonology* is the study of speech sounds in components of languages.

# truth

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"The truth will set you free." (John 8:32)

The *athlete* was doping; there was no hiding the **truth**.





# ἄμαρτία, ἡ

# sin

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"For sin will not rule over you." (Rom. 6:14)

*Hamartiology* is the study of **sin**.

**Sin** has alienated us from God, like *a Martian*.

# βασιλεία, ἡ

# kingdom, reign

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"Your kingdom come. Your will be done." (Matt. 6:10)

*Basel* is a city in Switzerland, not the United **Kingdom**.

# glory, majesty

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"... and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23)

A *doxology* is a word (*logos*) of God's **glory** and **majesty**.

# ἐκκλησία, ἡ

# congregation, assembly, church

"On this rock I will build my church." (Matt. 16:18)

D. A. Carson calls out people in the **church** who press the compound "ek" (out) "klesia" (called) too far.

*Ecclesiology* is the study of the **church**.

# ήμέρα, ή

# day

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“He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.” (1 Cor. 15:4)

Don't put off till *a morra*' what you can do in a **day**.

Feed *hay* to your *mare* once *a day*.

ephemeral (ἐπί + ἡμέρα, “for a day”)

# Abraham

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"Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day; he saw it and was glad." (John 8:56)

*Abraham* is a transliteration of the Hebrew name.

# I announce

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"Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, 'I have seen the Lord!'" (John 20:18)

This word is related to the word for *angel*, and angels often **announce** God's plan.

angel, angelic





ἀγιάζω

# I sanctify, consecrate

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"I sanctify myself for them, so that they also may be sanctified by the truth." (John 17:19)

The father **consecrated** the prodigal even though the son returned from a *hog yard* so dirty.

hagiography (a saint's biography)

# I buy

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"Another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen.'  
(Luke 14:19)

**I buy** my wife *a gorgeous* dress.
