God's Son died.

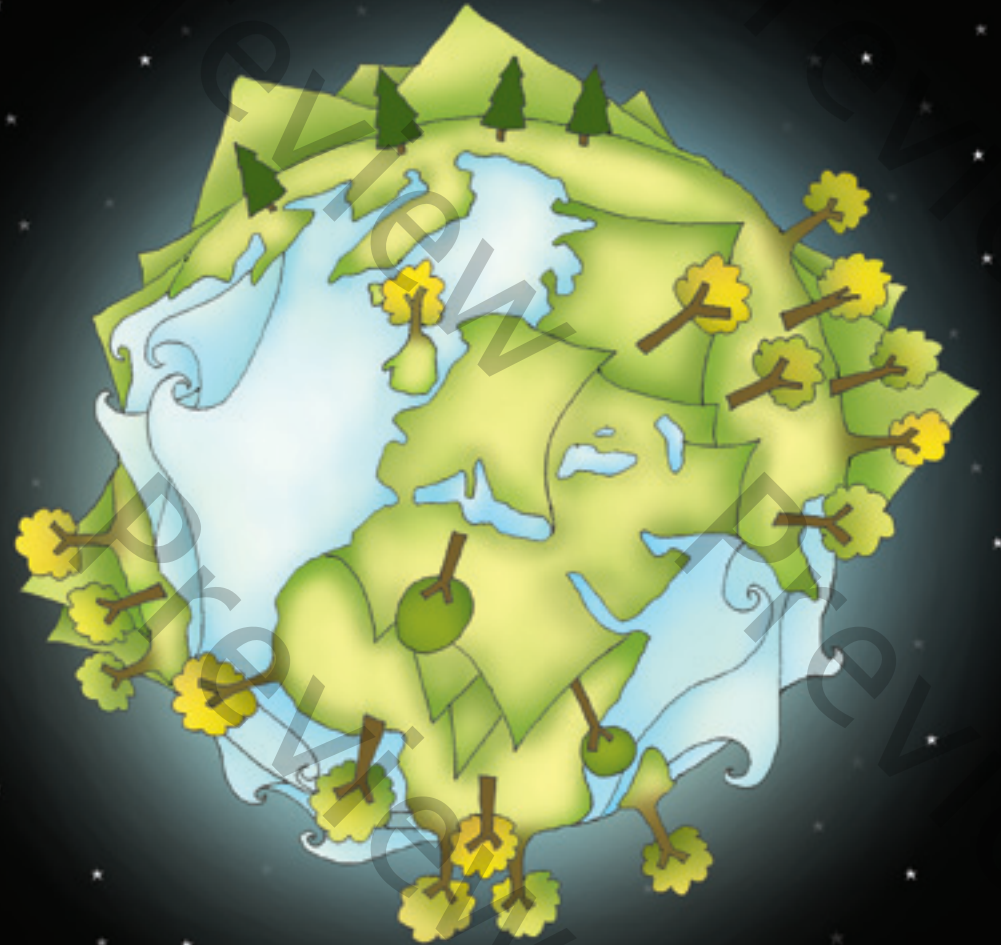




After all, it was Jesus who

But it was the only way.

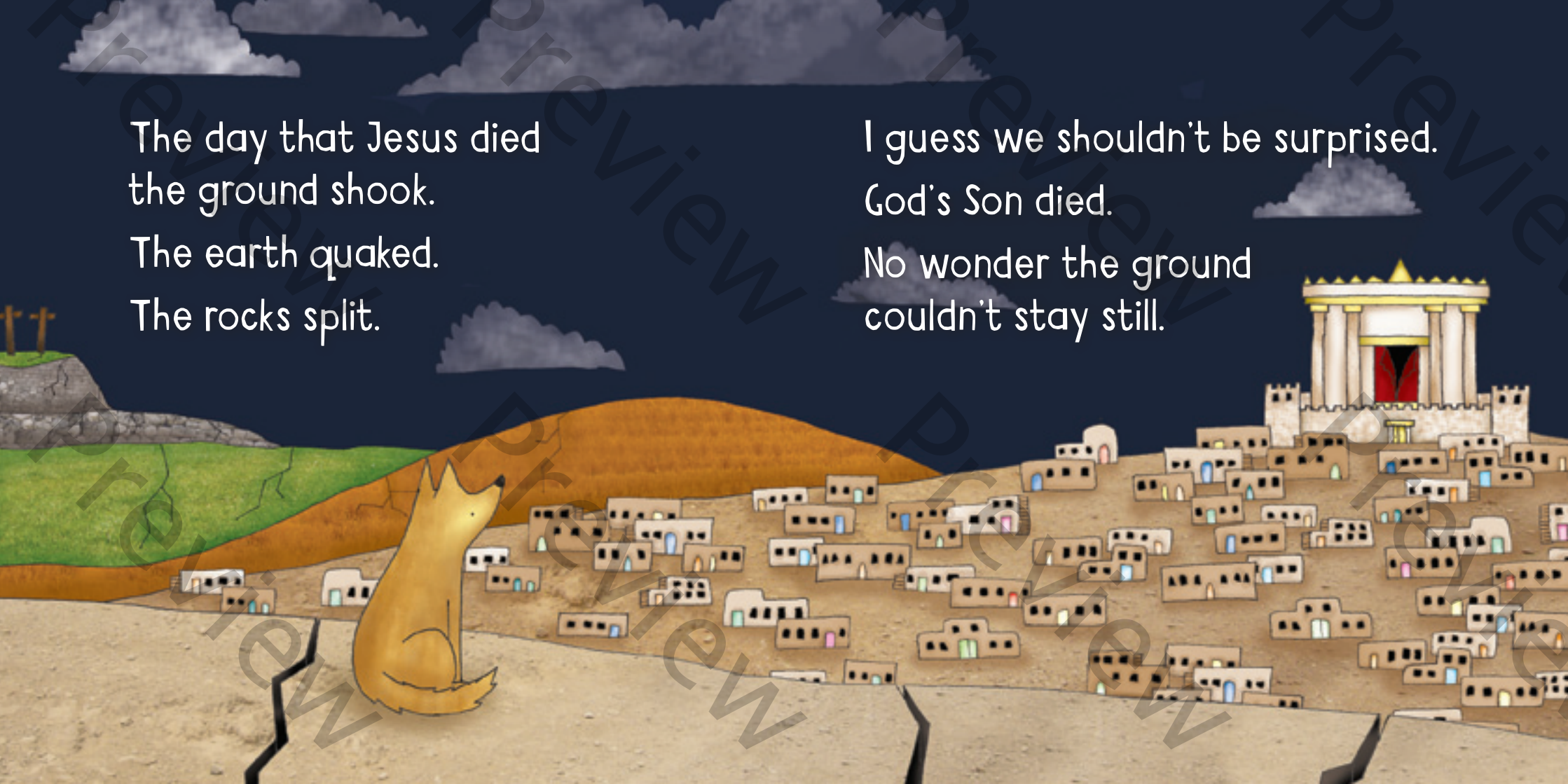
The Sinless for the sinful.

did was amazing.

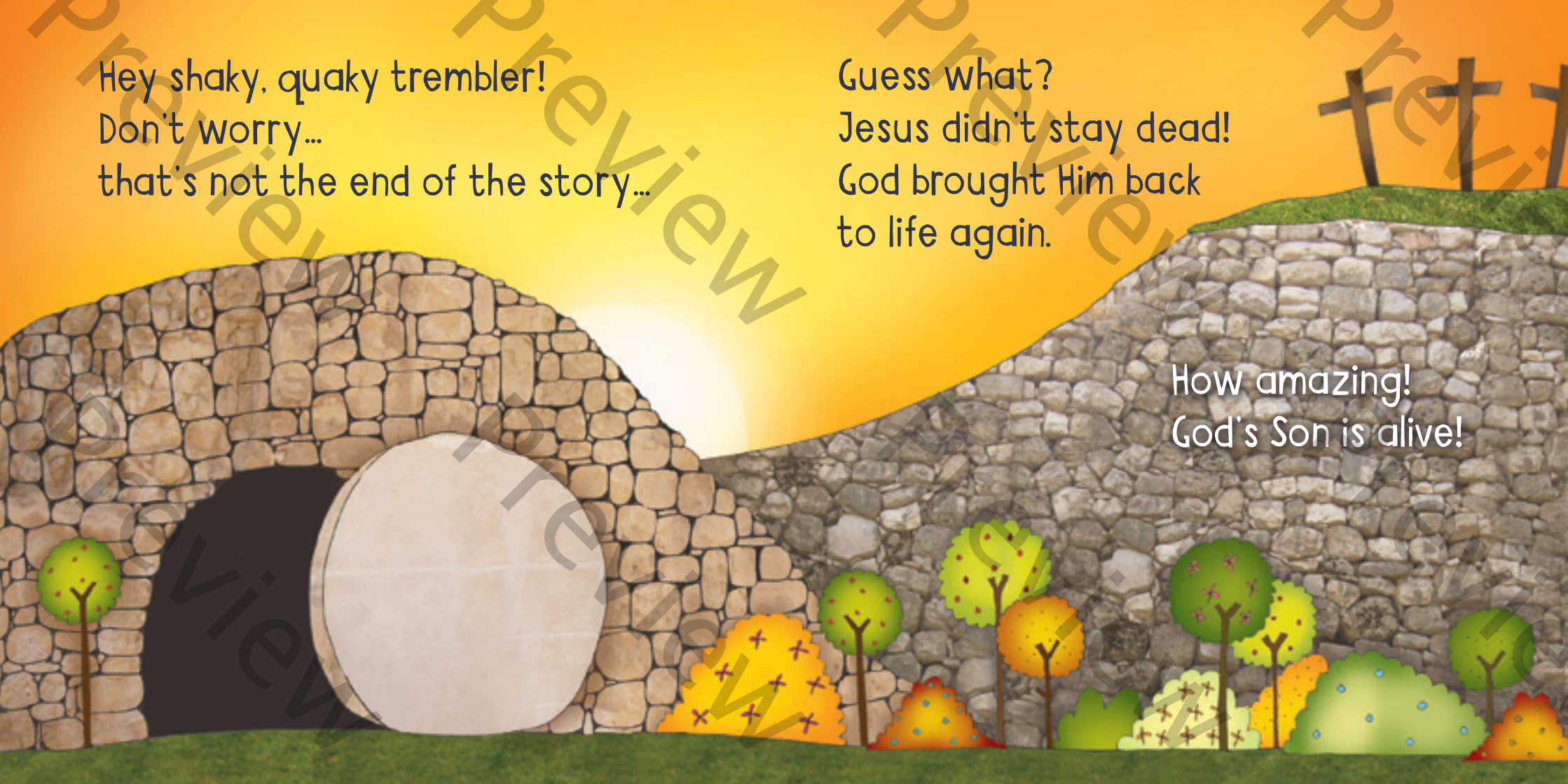
What Jesus did was super powerful,
