Church Partner Program

The Reformers Bookshop Church Partner Program is designed to:

- Encourage Christians to read great Christian books and
- Support the work of the gospel by helping to fund mission work

The Partner Program is simple! Here's how it works:

- A. Churches sign up (use the form below) and are given a Church Partner code
- B. Church members, family and friends purchase great Christian books from Reformers and quote their Church Partner code
- C. 15% of the value of the products purchased by the Church members is transferred to the Church's mission fund to further the work of the Gospel

Thank you for choosing Reformers Bookshop to help you in your ministry to the mission field. The following are guidelines for the Church Partner Program:

- 1. The following application is for 2018. This partnership can be renewed at the beginning of every calendar year.
- 2. Once the application is signed and approved, Reformers will provide the church with a Partner ID to be passed on to its members and their families.
- **3.** When the Partner ID is quoted, Reformers will donate 15% of a customer's purchase total, temporarily setting aside the amount in their system. The Partner ID must be given at the time of sale. The 15% cannot be applied post-sale.
- 4. Reformers will transfer into the Church's nominated account the accumulated total once it exceeds \$100 and/or at the close of the calendar year. The church must notify Reformers Bookshop if there are any changes to the bank details provided on the application form.
- 5. This offer is for purchases made by retail customers only.
- 6. The purchase must be a firm sale, paid in full, up front, and in one of the following ways: in store, over the phone or via our website.
 - Payment options include cash, cheque, debit cards, Visa/MasterCard, Reformers Gift Vouchers, and Reformers Gift Certificates.
 - Geneva Bursaries are already a donation and are not eligible as a method of payment with this program.
- 7. This offer can only be applied on items within the Reformers range.
- 8. The 15% is only calculated based on products purchased and does not apply to postage charges (if any).
- **9.** When purchasing Gift Certificates or Gift Vouchers, the 15% is not applied at that time. However, it is applied when a Partner ID is later used at the time of redeeming those Gift Certificates or Gift Vouchers.
- 10. Where other discounts (eg student or bulk) are applicable, the discounts are not added to the Partner Program. You may claim one, or the other, or a combination of the two up to the largest of the options. For example; customers who are eligible for a bulk discount greater than 15% have the following options:
 - The customer receives the greater %discount instead and forfeits the 15% for missions; or
 - The customer receives the greater %discount minus the 15%, and the 15% is given to the church's missions Partner account (e.g. 20% bulk discount customer receives a 5% discount and the 15% is given to missions); or
 - The customer pays full price, and passes on the full greater %discount to their church's missions Partner account (i.e. the savings from, say, a 20% bulk discount are instead given to missions).
- 11. The Partner Program is not available at conference bookstalls, unless specifically advertised.
- **12.** Churches that join the Partner Program will have any existing bookstall mission's opportunity discount raised from 10% to 15% to match the Partner Program offer. Congregation members do not need to quote the church's Partner ID in order to get the discount for the church, as it will be applied once the bookstall is completed.
