This panfish jig works great on those finicky fish. With the great movement of the Marabou tail and the sparkle of the Synthetic Hackle get ready to catch some fish!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

PAINTED BALLHEAD JIG | Yellow Glow w/Green Splash | 1/16

BODY | Crystal Synthetic Hackle | Chartreuse

TAIL | Strung Marabou | Chartreuse

THREAD | Danville Flymaster Plus
210 Denier | Fl. Green

« Step 1

Cut off the top of 1 feather. You want it to be a shank length long behind the hook. Tie in 3/4 of the way back towards the hook bend.

« Step 2

Tie in the hackle and wrap thread back to the head. Wrap the hackle forward. Make sure to place a few wraps to hold the hackle in place. Make 2-3 half hitches and you are ready to fish.
