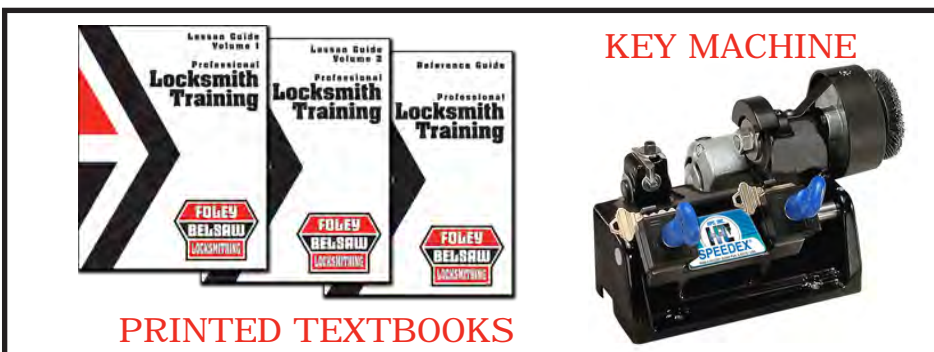

COURSE SCHEDULE
