




Tools Required (Not Supplied)

PRE-INSTALLATION AND TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS


- -All dimensions are shown in millimeters, except where otherwise indicated.
- -Ensure that the screen set is fitted to a level bathtub and vertical wall surface.
- -Please note: The wall fixings included with this product are suitable for solid walls only. Plasterboard or stud walls may require specialist fixings (not supplied).
- -Due to the possibility of residual spray, the area around the outside of the bathtub tray should be tiled, or made otherwise water resistant.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTES


- -Please handle all glass with care, avoiding knocks and shock loading to all sides and edges. Safety glass cannot be reworked.
- -Care should be taken when drilling into walls to avoid hidden pipes or electrical cables.


AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

-Soap and water will be adequate to clean the glass. A glass cleaner can be used if required -In hard water districts, insoluble lime salts may be deposited on the glass. If this deposit is allowed to build up it becomes increasingly difficult to remove and looks unsightly. Regular cleaning will minimize this effect.

Please ensure that the screen is fitted in the center of the rim of the bath Note: Failure to install the screen as shown with the lower bracket resting on the bath edge can result in excessive weight on the brackets causing them to fail.
