


FX Series FXH Series SXR Series B Series M - SM - AU Series










The guide below shows you how the bands differ in size as well as a brief description:



FX Series (coloured/nonstick band)

- The longest band (buccal to lingual). Ideal for a large preps, or when using the wide green ring.
- This curved band fits the anatomy of the tooth, making it easier to go subgingivally.
- Includes a grab tab for easy placement.

FX, SXR, SM series (coloured/nonstick band)

- These bands all have a non-stick coating, making them much easier to remove! (The chemistry in newer dental adhesives and composites can make it challenging to remove non-coated bands.)
- Colour coding makes it easier for dental team members to identify the bands clinically and when reordering.

FXH series (silver - not pictured above)

- The newest addition! An extra firm matrix band.
- It is the same thickness as the FX but constructed from a denser material, giving it the feeling of being firm.
- Ideal for tight interproximal spaces where other bands may crumple more easily upon insertion.
- Silver colour, curved, and slightly shorter (buccal to lin-gual) than the FX series.
- Includes a grab tab for easy placement.

B series (silver)

- The original sectional matrix bands!
- Shortest in length ideal for Pedo

M (silver), AU (gold) and SM (coloured/nonstick) series

- Band size & thickness is the same for all.
- Available in Silver (M), Gold (AU), Coloured/Non-stick (SM)
