Pianofest will be held at Holburn West Church, Aberdeen throughout the week. It is a great opportunity to gain confidence in performing to an audience in a supportive environment with helpful and valuable feedback received from the adjudicators.

Classes are Own Choice.

For classes marked with an "X" titles are required with the entry and are helpful for programming for all classes.

Copies of the works being performed should be provided for the adjudicator on the day, unless a set book has been specified.

Pianists are reminded that:

- they may only perform a work once, in one piano class
- they can enter more than one class but they must be in adjacent grades.
- that they can take part in any class on a non-competitive basis and receive a full adjudication.
