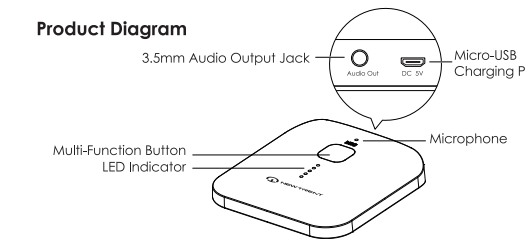

Product Diagram

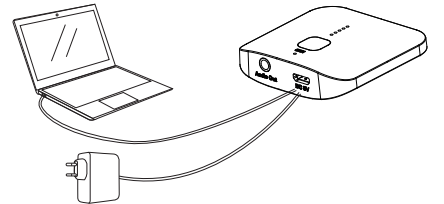

Getting Started

Please fully charge NT720 before the first use. To charge, connect it to a USB charger or charging port with the included micro-USB cable. When the red LED indicator turns off, your NT720 is fully charged and ready for use. Charging takes around 2.5 hours.



Powering On / Off

- Press and hold the multi-function button for 3 seconds to power "on" with the LED indicator flashing blue and red lights simultaneously three times.
- Press and hold the multi-function button for 5 seconds to power "off" with the LED indicator turning off.

Pairing

1. Power on the NT720 and it will automatically enter pairing mode with the LED indicator flashing red and blue alternately.
2. Activate the pairing function of your bluetooth compatible audio device (like a smartphone) and select "NT720".
3. If a code or pin is required for pairing, enter "0000".
4. When successfully connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue.
5. Connect one end of the included 3.5mm audio cable to the 3.5mm audio jack on the NT720, and connect the other end of the cable to your audio equipment (speaker, stereo system, or car audio system). Or connect your wired headphones directly to the NT720 for audio.

Simultaneous Connection with Two Devices

The NT720 can simultaneously connect two bluetooth devices (such as phones), but sound can only be received from one source at a time.

1. Follow the instructions in the "Pairing" section to pair the NT720 with Device A.
2. Once paired, disable the bluetooth function on Device A and the receiver will automatically enter pairing mode. Or you can long-press the multi-function button for 2 seconds to enter pairing mode.
3. Follow the instructions in the "pairing" section to pair with Device B.
4. Once paired with Device B, reactivate the bluetooth function on Device A and select "NT720" in the list of paired devices.

Notes

- The NT720 will automatically enter standby mode after 2 minutes in pairing mode if no device is paired.
- If your paired device is turned off or disconnected or out of operating range (10m/33ft), the NT720 will automatically enter pairing mode. After 2 minutes, the NT720 will change to standby mode. Select "NT720" in your device to reconnect the last successfully paired device.
- The receiver will automatically shut down after 10 minutes if it is not connected with any devices.

Controls & LED Indicator

Functions	Instructions
Answer / End a call	Short-press multi-function button
Reject an incoming call	Press and hold the multi-function button for 2 seconds
Redial last-called number	Double-press the multi-function button when connected
Voice switching	During a call, double-press the multi-function button to switch from the device to your phone for talking
Device switch	When you have 2 phones connected and get a call on one during a call on the other, double-press the multi-function button to switch between two phone calls
Play / Pause	Press multi-function button once
Cancel pairing	Long-press the multi-function button for 2 seconds

LED Indicator	Status
Blue and red flash alternately	Pairing mode
Blue on	Connected / Playing music
Blue flashes steadily	Standby time
Blue quickly flashes three times every 5 seconds	Incoming call
Blue and red simultaneously flashes once every 3 seconds	In call
Red flashes	Low battery
Red on	Charging
Red off	Fully charged
Light off	Power off
