

SUBLATIVE AND SUBLIME POST-TREATMENT CARE

- → Non-steroidal, anti-inflammatory (NSAID) agents are recommended for use.
- → Transient skin erythema and edema, as well as heat or tingling sensations, may last up to several hours after treatment.
- → If post-treatment discomfort is experienced, the patient may cool the area with cold (not frozen) compresses.
- → Tiny scabs of less than 1 mm diameter will usually form 24-72 hours post-treatment and may remain for a few days. The scabs should not be touched or scratched, and should be allowed to shed off naturally.
- → The patient should use a high-factor sunscreen (at least 30 SPF) and protect the treated area from sunlight during the entire course of treatment and <u>for at</u> <u>least one month after</u>.
- → The patient should use plenty of moisturizing cream between treatments (Aquaphor is recommended) starting 12 hours after treatment.
