

## USE INSTRUCTIONS

### SOLAR USB MOOD LIGHT WITH REMOTE CONTROL

**\*IMPORTANT \***

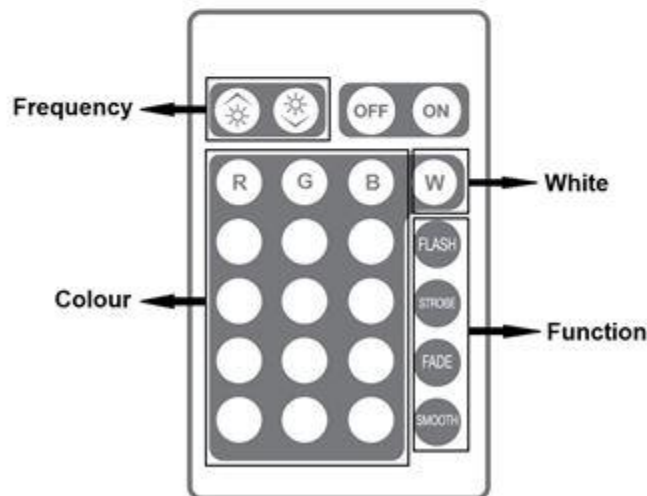
The performance of the light is determined by the amount of sunlight that reaches the solar panel. This will be affected by a number of factors such as location and weather condition.

**Before You Start**

- 1) Study the instructions carefully, check the pack and make sure you have all of the parts.
- 2) Decide on an appropriate location for your product, make sure that you have plenty of space and a clean dry area for locate.
- 3) Retain the instructions for future use.

**Care & Use**

- 1) Product is for indoor and outdoor use.
- 2) To clean the lights, just wipe with a damp cloth. And to keep them looking good for longer, we recommend that you store the mood light indoor during the winter months.
- 3) The mood light confirms with IP44 while the USB cable and remote control are not water proof.
- 4) Try to position the product under direct sunlight for most of the day. We don't recommend putting this item near walls or in the shade.
- 5) The mood light can only be switched on/ off in dark conditions. To switch on, press the ON/OFF button at the bottom of the mood light. To switch off, press the ON/OFF button and hold for about 3 seconds. You can also switch ON/OFF using the remote control (see picture below).
- 6) The mood light is designed to automatically illuminate in dark conditions. If you wish to permanently switch off the light, keep it in the dark once switched off.
- 7) You can choose light colour through remote control by pressing "Colour" buttons or "White" button. (NOTE: Colours of buttons on remote control maybe varied against actual light colours).
- 8) You can choose light patterns through remote control by pressing "Function" buttons. Also the frequency can be adjusted by press up/ down "Frequency" button.



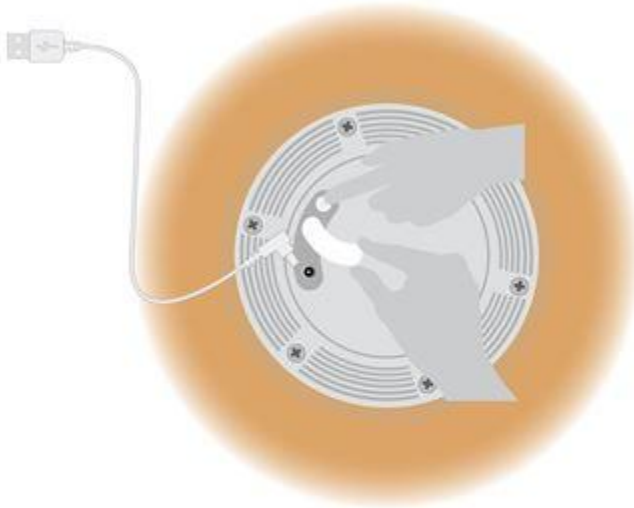
### Charging the mood light:

The mood light can be charged via USB cable or by solar power.

It's a good idea to allow the product to fully charge before using it for the first time.

The input voltage of USB cable 5 V, the output voltage 4.2 V.

- 1) Charge the mood light by positioning it under direct sunlight for at least 6 hours.
- 2) You can also charge through the USB cable provided (see picture below).  
As the cable and remote control is not water-proof, please charge it indoors.  
When charging using the USB cable, the mood light will turn red, once finished, it will turn blue.



### Warnings

- 1) The LED lights in this product are long-lasting and cannot be replaced.
- 2) DO NOT press the top of the product as this may damage the case.
- 3) DO NOT dispose of batteries in a fire.
- 4) Dispose batteries responsibly at a local authority household waste recycling facility.
- 5) Bring indoors during periods of severe weather or high winds.
- 6) Keep the remote control out of reach of children under 8 years old.

### Battery Replacement

- 1) The battery of the mood light is standard rechargeable Lithium 3.7V 2000 mAh and it cannot be replaced.
- 2) Battery of the remote control is 3V CR2025 Lithium button cell which can be replaced.
- 3) This product should be disposed of responsibly at the end of its life. Please recycle where facilities exist. Check with your local authority or retailer for recycling advice.
