

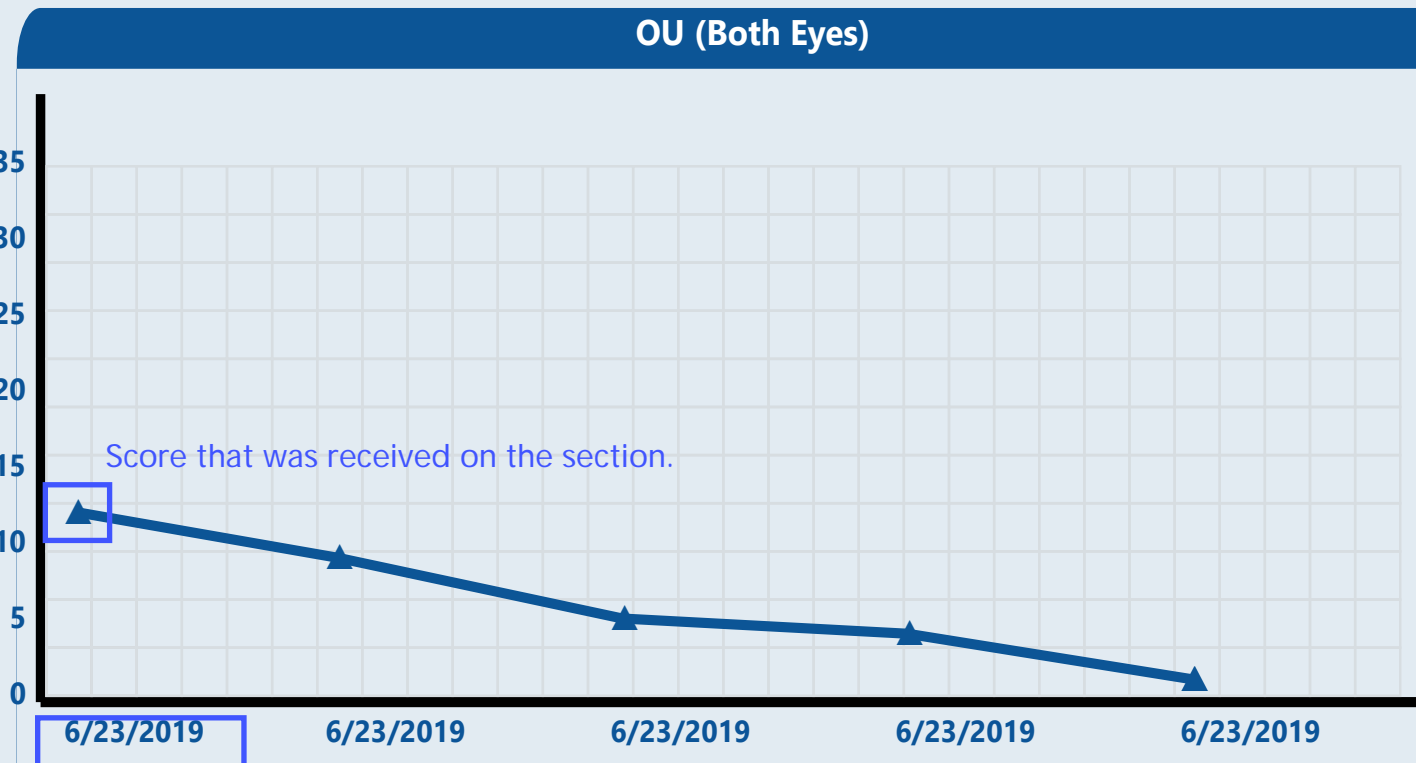


Compare Test Results

This is a demonstration of what an acquired color vision deficiency may look like over time. It is an easy way to measure progression of ocular diseases and toxicity.



Date the test was taken. The same date is displayed here for demonstration purposes.

Legend for deficiency types:

- General (Black square)
- Tritan (Blue triangle) - Selected
- Protan (Red circle)
- Deutan (Green star)

Each deficiency is identified by a color and shape. For this example, only the tritan is being compared over time.

Legend for eye tested:

- OS (Left eye)
- OD (Right eye)
- OU (Both eyes) - Selected

This shows what eye was tested and is being displayed in the bar graph above.
