

Care and Maintenance Instructions

Care & Preventative Maintenance

It is normal for any hard surface finish to show scuffs, scratches, and indentations caused by normal everyday living, pets and minor mishaps. Use of protective pads under chair legs, table legs and furniture is one of the basic keys to preventing scuffs and scratches. Minimize the use of street shoes on flooring and avoid high-heeled shoes with bottom heels worn through to the steel spike as they can cause considerable damage to any finished flooring. Mats at entrances will help keep small rocks and debris from scratching your finish.

It is important to keep any prefinished hard surface products dry. Wring mop heads or rags well before applying to a prefinished surface. To minimize possible water damage, wet mopping, water leaks and applying cleaning agents directly to the prefinished products should be avoided.

Rinse Cleaning pad often to avoid streaking
Refill as necessary
