

Care and Maintenance Instructions Polyurethane Finishes

PID Floors are a beatufiul addition to your home and have been created to ensure that looking after them is easy. All PID Floors flooring is made with Click joint technology and are easy to care for. The following steps will ensure that your PID flooring will look beautiful for years.

General Care

Dust-mop (with a non-treated, clean mop) or vacuum floors regularly to remove loose soil and fine dust particles that can scratch finished floors. Wipe up spills on floors immediately with cloth or sponge. Clean as required with PSXP001.

Use only PSXP001 on your PID floor.

Never use wet mops, highly acidic or alkaline cleaners, non-recommended commercial floor cleaners or polishes, treated mops that have been used to clean other floors or furniture.

Place felt floor protector pads on furniture feet and protect your floor from hard castors on moveable furniture.

High heels and pet nails can cause permanent indenation in floor surfaces. Use caution when wearing high heels, and keep pets' nails trimmed.

70%-80% of dirt on the floors in your home is tracked in from the outside. One square yard of matting can capture one pound of soil. Use entryway (non-skid, cotton) mats to capture tracked-in dirt and soil, and clean them regularly. Rubber or fiber-backed mats may stain or scratch floor finish.

Shade variation should be expected with flooring made from natural products like hardwood. Color changes will occur to your floor with exposure to sunlight.

To help minimize expansion and contraction of your PID floor, use a humidifier or dehumidifier to maintain an even level of humidity. The recommended humidity range for all PID floors is 30%-60%.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove mop cloth from mop head (if applicable). Thoroughly rinse mop cloth with warm water, fold and wring out as dry as possible. Hold mop in both hands and flap vigorously to shake free any loose fibers. Replace mop cloth onto mop head. Lightly spray 2-3 sprays of PSXP001 directly onto mop cloth. (Cleans approximately 2.3 square meters or 25 square feet.) DO NOT spray cleaner directly on floor, as streaking will occur. In smooth, continuous "S" motion, sweep mop up and down length of floor, within comfortable reach. As mop starts to leave dry spots on floor, lift mop head and look for dirt and particle build up. If dirt persists, clean mop head and begin again. If no dirt or particles are visible, apply another 2-3 sprays onto mop head and continue cleaning floor from where you left off. Continue process of cleaning, inspecting and re-applying PSXP001 until entire floor area is cleaned. Once floor is clean, remove mop cloth from mop head, rinse clean with warm water and hang to dry before storing cloth. Store bottle in upright position. Do not allow PSXP001 to freeze. If freezing occurs, allow cleaner to warm to room temperature before use.

NOTE

Use only PSXP001 on PID Click floors. This specially formulated neutral cleaner will not harm floors. Use of nonrecommended cleaners with high pH content will damage floors and may void warranty.

CAUTION

Inhalation of spray mists may cause irritation to nose. Will cause irritation of eye on contact. Will cause irritation of mouth and throat; may cause nausea, vomiting, cramps and diarrhea if swallowed. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Keep container closed. Remove and launder contaminated clothing. Do not breathe spray mists. Do not spray directly towards face or other people.

FIRST AID

In case of inhalation, remove to fresh air. Eyes: Immediately flush with cool water. Remove contact lenses, continue flushing for 15 minutes, holding eyelids apart to ensure rinsing or entire eye. Contact physician if irritation persists. Skin: Rinse skin with water. Ingestion: DO NOT INDUCE VOMIT-ING. Rinse mouth and give 1-2 glasses of water. Consult physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to unconscious person.
