### FSC®

FSC® is the most rigorous international standard for responsible forestry. FSC® certified forests conserve biological diversity, water resources and crucial ecosystems. The FSC® standard also upholds worker rights and supports economic prosperity in surrounding communities. The FSC® Chain of Custody certification ensures that certified wood products are tracked from forest to final product (and if applicable, that qualified recycled materials are used), adding legitimacy to the FSC® claim throughout the supply chain.

### CARB PHASE 2 COMPLIANCE

The California Air Resource Board (CARB) established formaldehyde emission standards as part of a regulation to reduce formaldehyde emissions from composite wood products (California regulation 93120). PID Floors continuously monitors federal air emissions regulations for product compliance.

### FloorScore®

FloorScore® is a third party certification developed by the Resilient Floor Covering Institute and Scientific Certification Systems to meet the strict indoor air quality thresholds set forth by the California Section 01350 program. This standard certifies flooring products in accordance with the volatile organic compounds emissions tested with the criteria set forth in ASTM D5116: Standard Guide for Small-Scale Environmental Chamber Determinations of Organic Emissions From Indoor Materials/Products.
