GENERAL PRINCIPLE

A scratch is applied onto the specimen surface under a constant normal load over a distance of 0.1 m (60.0001 m) at a constant scratch rate of 0.1m/s (60.0005 m/s). This test mode is intended to evaluate the load-dependent response of the material and establish the weight load required to produce scratch penetration. The constant load value was increased if the load used is insufficient to generate damage on the specimen.
