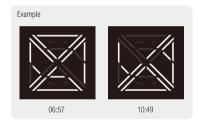


Change the way you think about time



1. How to read the time

- · Press button A to display the time.
- . The LEDs will light up and the time will be shown.
- The time is displayed digitally, the hour can be read from top to bottom and minutes from left to right.
- . The time display will turn off after 10 seconds.





2. How to read the date

- · Press button B to display the date.
- . The date icon indicates that you are in date mode.
- . The LEDs will light up and the date will be shown.
- The date is displayed digitally, the month can be read from top and bottom and date from left to right.
- . The date display will turn off after 10 seconds.





3. How to set the time

 When the time is displayed, press and hold button B for 3 seconds to enter setting mode.

*Note after 10 seconds of inactivity setting mode will deactivate

I. Setting 12/24 Hour Mode

- . The time can be displayed in 12 or 24 hour mode.
- . Press button B to change the time mode as required.
- . Press button A to confirm and move to the hour.

II. Setting the hour

- The hour digits will flash when you are in hour setting mode.
- The PM indicator in setting mode indicates that you are setting the time in PM.
- Press button B to increase the hour as required.
- . Press button A to confirm and move to the minutes.

III. Setting the minutes

- The minute digits will flash when you are in minute setting mode.
- . Press button B to increase the minutes as required.
- . Press button A to confirm and move to the animation.

IV. Setting the animation

- The display will either flash or animate when you are in animation setting mode.
- Press button B to turn the animation on or off. When the animation is off, the display will flash, when the animation is on, the display will animate.
- . Press button A to confirm and exit setting mode.

4. How to set the date

 When the date is displayed, press and hold button B for 3 seconds to enter date setting mode.

*Note after 10 seconds of inactivity setting mode will deactivate

Setting the year

- The year digits will flash when you are in year setting mode.
- The date icons indicate that you are in date setting mode.
- · Press button B to increase the year as required.
- · Press button A to confirm and move to the month.

II. Setting the month

- The month digits will flash when you are in month setting mode.
- · Press button B to increase the month as required.
- · Press button A to confirm and move to the date.

III. Setting the date

- The date digits will flash when you are in date setting mode.
- · Press button B to increase the date as required.
- · Press button A to confirm and exit setting mode.

5. Checking and setting the alarm

I. Checking the alarm

- · Press button B twice to display the alarm time.
- The alarm mode icon indicates that you are in alarm mode. The alarm on icon indicates that the alarm is on.

(II. Setting the alarm

 When the alarm time is displayed, press and hold button B for 3 seconds to enter alarm setting mode.

*Note after 10 seconds of inactivity setting mode will deactivate

- . The alarm mode icon will be flashing.
- Press button B to turn the alarm on or off. The alarm on icon indicates that the alarm is on.
- . Press button A to confirm and move to the hour.
- · Press button B to increase the hour as required.
- The PM icon in alarm setting mode indicates that you are setting the alarm time in PM.
- . Press button A to confirm and move to the minutes.
- . Press button B to increase the minutes as required.
- · Press button A to confirm and exit alarm setting mode.

6. How to recharge the battery

- . This watch has a USB rechargeable battery.
- When the lights become dim or do not light up, you should recharge the battery.
- To recharge the battery, unscrew the USB cap using the screw driver provided and connect the USB charging cable to the USB charging jack.
- Connect the charging cable to a power source, e.g. your computer.
- · When charging, the LED charging indicator will blink.
- When the charging indicator stops blinking, the battery is 90% charged.

It is advised that you continue to charge the battery for a full 3.5 hours to ensure the battery is 100% charged.



- It is advised that you use the screw driver provided when opening the USB cap so as not to damage the head of the screw.
- · Items included in the box:
 - Watch
 - USB cable
 - Spare USB cap
 - Screwdriver
 - Instruction Manual

7. User information

I. Battery

- This watch uses an PL301517 rechargeable battery only.
- Battery lifetime will vary depending on use, but is estimated at approximately 300 charges.
- To maximise battery life you should limit the use of the animation.
- The plug standard input voltage for the PL301517 battery is DC3.7V. You should use only the cable provided with the watch when recharging.

II. Warranty

 This watch is covered by a 1 year warranty. This warranty does not cover water damage, accidental damage, neglect or unauthorized repair.

III. Caution

 This watch is water resistant to 3ATM. Please do not use the watch in the shower, for swimming or for other water related activities.
