- Generous width of gullet to alleviate spinal trauma.
- Standard 3" gusset for positive influence on saddle balance.
- Stirrup bar angulated in awareness of tree/ body width.
- Tree structured to accommodate today's sport horse bodies.



Design Strategy for the Rider

- Resilient, well cushioned seat to lessen fatigue and improve feel.
- Three models to provide unique seat contour choices.
- Anatomically shaped thigh block that is contoured for enhanced drape of your leg.
- Modeled flap creates closest contact in leg position.
