## SCHIA NANA

Botanical Name: Ruschia lineolata 'Nana' Common Name: Dwarf Carpet of Stars

<u>Origin:</u> A selection (PPAF) of species *Ruschia lineolata*, from South Africa

## Features:

- VERY DROUGHT TOLERANT
- FULL SUN to HALF SHADE
- LOW GROWING (1-2" TALL)
- GREEN YEAR AROUND
- LOW MAINTENANCE, NO
   MOWING
- EXTREMELY DURABLE
- WEED SUPPRESSING
- SMALL WHITE FLOWERS with PINK STRIPES in LATE WINTER / EARLY SPRING
- WIDE TEMPERATURE RANGE 20°F to 120°F

 Planting Time: Year around, faster to establish in Spring/Summer than Fall/Winter

 Plug Spacing: 6" on center recommended, 12" o.c. is slower but budget-friendly.

 Estimated Fill-in Time: At 6" o.c., fill in time is 3-5 months, at 12" o.c., fill in time is 5-7 months

 Site Preparation:

 Same process as standard lawn preparation

Planting: Plugs should be planted so that the plug soil level is even with landscape soil level. Make sure plugs and planting area are moist prior to planting. Planting Location: Ruschia 'Nana' may be planted on flat ground and gentle slopes

Light: Ruschia 'Nana' is light and heat loving and will do best in full sun, down to a minimum of a half day of sunlight.

Temperature: Current data suggest that Ruschia 'Nana' will tolerate temperatures ranges as high as 120°F and as low 20°F.

Watering: Once established, Ruschia 'Nana' will only require a deep irrigation once every 8-10 days in Summer, less in Winter.

Fertilization: Ruschia 'Nana' does not have a high fertilizer requirement, but will benefit from two annual applications of a balanced 15-15-15 fertilizer.

Pests: Ruschia 'Nana' has no major insect pests. Diligence should be exercised during plug establishment to remove all sprouting weeds to avoid infestation.
