VINTAGE REPORT

The 2017 vintage resulted in a later harvest than we have seen in many years due to the wetter winter and spring months and the below average temperatures in December and January combined with some timely rain in late January and early February. With good soil moisture and cooler temperatures the fruit ripened slowly, ensuing a gradual accumulation of sugars and flavour synonymous with high quality Barossa wines. The fruit harvested was has wonderful length of fruit flavours, good natural acidity and balanced sugar levels. The 2017 vintage wines will show exceptional elegance and finesse. The yields were slightly above average. All in-all a wonderful vintage.



TASTING NOTE

Pale in colour with light green tinges. Lifted aromatics of citrus, lime and lemons balanced with some perfumes, floral and sherbet notes. A complex bouquet that will entice the drinker. The palate is clean, long and well balanced with seamless acidity and a tight mineral, steely edge.

VINEYARDS

The fruit comes from the Eden Valley vineyard located within the Barossa. This vineyard was planted in the 1960's and yields 2.5t/ hectare.
