


Components



The aluminium tube included with the clamp is packing material and should be discarded.

- 1. Camera Platform
- 2. Camera Mounting Screw
- 3. Tightening Knob
- 4. Camera Locking Knob
- 5. Camera Platform Locking Knob
- 6. Clamp (A)
- 7. Clamp (B)
- 8. Clamp Lock

Attaching To A Leg



Clamp to leg, and tighten clamp lock.





When attaching the clamp to a rectangular leg section, fellow Figure A. Figure B shows the incorrect way to attach which can result in the clamp coming loose during tripod operation.











Attaching A Camera




Hold camera and engage threads by turning the Camera Locking Knob.




Tighten camera by turning the Tightening Knob.
